## In-Person Worship Details

- If you are planning to attend in-person services:
  - Beginning Nov. 28, proof of vaccination must be provided by inperson service attendees.
  - We are required to wear masks and practice social distancing at the LSC.
  - We hope these implementations will make our services more accessible to those who are ineligible to receive a vaccine (immunocompromised, children under 12, etc.). Those who are ineligible may attend without being vaccinated.
  - Please do not attend in-person services if you are experiencing any COVID-like symptoms, or have possibly been in contact with someone who has COVID.
- Please notify our office if you have tested positive for COVID-19 and have attended our in-person services within the last two weeks of your positive result.
- If you are not yet vaccinated, we invite you to join us online via Zoom or Facebook Live.
- Please let us know if you would be able to assist as a volunteer on Sundays as we will need help with ensuring that pandemic protocols are followed.

Please note that the changes above have been approved by our Leadership Team following recommendations made by Chief Medical Health Officer Dr. Saqib Shahab that places of worship should require proof of vaccinations. This decision was also made based on our commitment to create a safer space for our community. The survey indicated that 65% of respondents would be more comfortable attending in person worship with a proof of vaccination policy (26% are already comfortable).

**COVID Protocols:** We thank you for helping us keep our community safe as we continue to monitor the pandemic. This practice and policy is consistent with the recommendations of the Living Skies Regional Council and the United Church of Canada, and done in a manner that is meaningful for our community and is safe for every member of our congregation. 


The next Craft/Study sessions will begin on January 13 - the book for these sessions is "Faith After Doubt" by Brian McLaren.
