- **Riders must wear a ASTM/SEI certified helmet at all times when mounted!!!**
- Every class offered herein which is covered by the specifications and rules of the current MHSA Regional Guidelines will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Show Points

Ribbons will be awarded to eight places for each non-medal class, plus Division Champion and Reserve Champion. Medal classes will be awarded to six places. Points and ribbons will be awarded as follows:

1 st place	10 points
2 nd place	6 points
3 rd place	4 points
4 th place	3 points
5 th place	2 point
6 th place	1.5point
7 th place	1 points
8 th place	.5 points

Division Champion will receive an additional 10 points and Reserve Champion will receive an additional 6 points. All Snowflake division championships at each show and the Snowflake Series End division championships will be determined using this method.

Any Snowflake division that runs with less than 3 entries will receive ½ points. Champion will receive 5 points and Reserve Champion will receive 3 points.

Ties for Championships and Reserves

In the event there is a tie in a Hunter Division, the Championship will be awarded to the animal with the highest number of points in the Over Fences Classes. If a tie still exists, the two that are tied will return to the ring and be shown at a walk/trot/canter and will be counted as an independent under saddle class. If one of the tied competitors does not want to hack or has left the show grounds, the remaining competitor will receive the award by forfeit. If neither of the competitors wants to hack, the tie may be decided by a coin toss.

For Pleasure Divisions, the two competitors that are tied will return to the ring and be shown at a walk/trot/canter and will be counted as an independent under saddle class. If one of the tied competitors does not want to hack or has left the show grounds, the remaining competitor will receive the award by forfeit. If neither of the competitors wants to hack, the tie may be decided by a coin toss.

Snowflake Series Awards

To be considered for Snowflake Horse Show Series End Awards, both the rider and/or horse must earn points in a division at a minimum of **3** horse shows.

Entry Procedures

- Each horse/rider combination must complete an entry form in order to be assigned a number.
- Entries received via fax, email or postmarked by the pre-entry deadline, and adhering to all entry procedures, will be pre-entered in all of the appropriate classes/divisions, and will receive the pre-entry discount.
- Any entry that does not pay their fees the day of the show will be charged a \$15 late payment fee. If payment has not been received within 30 days of the show date, the entry will not receive any points earned at that show. Also, no horse/rider will be allowed to compete in future shows at Autumn Grove Stables until payment has been made.
- Checks returned for insufficient funds will incur a \$30 returned check fee.

The show manager reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors and prohibit entries; to rotate judges; to change location, combine, cancel or limit any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors.

Entry Rules

Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and omissions.

Entry/Cross Entry-Exhibitors are responsible for knowing the Rules and Regulations governing the horse show, and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of a violation of a cross entry restriction, the exhibitor will forfeit the entry fee and the class placing. The Snowflake Series shows are run in accordance with the MHSA Regulations. Copies of the MHSA Regional Guidelines will be available in the Horse Show office.

Point Discrepancy

Every effort is made to record points accurately. However, it is inevitable that mistakes may be made. Please check the points on a regular basis and follow-up via email with the Show Secretary if you find a discrepancy as soon as possible. The Show Secretary will review the judges' cards for the class results in question. If an error is discovered, the points will be corrected. **Any discrepancies must be reported within 30 days after the points have been posted on the website. After 30 days, posted points will become final.**

Age Requirements

For all MHSA Regional Classes and Divisions, competition age of the rider is based on their age as of December 1, 2018, per the MHSA Regional Guidelines. Because the Snowflake Series runs from September through March, there may be some confusion as to if a rider eligible for certain classes and divisions. For example, if a rider turned 10 on or before December 1, 2018, they may compete in the Short Stirrup Equitation Division in September, and October. However, if they have turned 11 before December 1, 2019 the rider will not be eligible to compete in that division for the remainder of the Snowflake Series Season. Their points will still count towards the Series End Awards for the Snowflake Awards.

For all unrated Snowflake Classes and Divisions, competition age of the rider is based on their age as of September 1, 2019. This will allow riders to accumulate points for the entire show season in those classes and divisions.

Please do not hesitate to ask the Show Secretary (Tara Ellis) or one of the Show Managers (Kristie Naughton and Katie Dykes) if you have any questions.

Coggins/Health Requirements

To meet Maryland Coggins test requirements, an exhibitor must provide at each show or have on file with the Horse Show Office, a negative Coggins test dated within one year of the competition dates for each horse show. Any horse not in compliance will be asked to leave the show grounds. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to make sure the Coggins is submitted with their entry forms. Please bring a copy of your current negative Coggins for the Horse Show Office to keep on file.

All horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds. Horses not in compliance with this rule will be required to leave the competition grounds. Please bring a copy of your current vaccination records for the Horse Show Office to keep on file.

Stalls

Overnight season stalls are available for \$250 for the season. This includes Friday night schooling. Overnight stalls are available to rent for \$50/nt per show. Day stalls are available to rent for \$35/day per show. Arrangements must be made when submitting your entries. The fee does not include hay or shavings. Hay and shavings may be purchased through the Horse Show Office.

Pets

All dogs must be on a leash, no longer than 6 feet and attached to a human. Owners of free-running or unattended dogs will receive a warning. Repeated offenses may result in a fine of \$50.

Measurement Cards

If you are planning to show in any MHSA rated pony divisions, you must possess a valid measurement card or copy of a valid measurement form to be presented to the Show Secretary. Numbers will not be issued before this requirement has been met. Measurements can be done at each show prior to the start of the first class. Please notify the Show Secretary in advance if you would like to have a pony measured. If you are planning to show in only unrated Snowflake Series Divisions, you do not need to provide a pony measurement card, unless the proof of size eligibility is challenged.

Schooling

Friday Evening Schooling (2:00pm-8:00pm)

- Both rings will be available for schooling.
- No lunging is allowed in rings.
- **The cost for schooling Friday night is \$20 (if you do not have a stall).**

Saturday Morning Schooling (7:00am-7:45am)

- Both rings will be available for schooling over fences.
- No lunging is allowed in rings.

Saturday Schooling (during the show)

- Two Schooling rings will be available for schooling over fences.
- No lunging is allowed in rings.
- Unjudged schooling rounds have been added to the show schedule for both rings.

Schooling Round Over Fences

Unjudged schooling rounds are for any rider who wishes to warm up over fences just prior to their class. One schooling round per entry, per ring is allowed. Show management reserves the right to limit the number of fences jumped in Unjudged Schooling Rounds. Judge must be informed of a rider's intent to complete an unjudged schooling round **before** entering the ring. Failure to do so may result in entry being disqualified from the class for which the warm-up precedes.

Classes/divisions may be canceled or combined if there are less than 4 entries. Unrated divisions will **only** be split if there are more than 10 entries or at the show manager's discretion. **Divisions will not be split in the rated divisions.**

English Pleasure Class Descriptions

Martingales are not permitted in any pleasure class

Under Saddle (U/S)-To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on suitability of horse or pony to purpose, manners and ability to give a safe, comfortable ride.

Park Mount-To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot or similar gait and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged as pleasurable handling and riding characteristics with emphasis on manners and gait. To back readily and stand quietly. May be asked to move on at the canter.

Combination Hack-To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. At least 8 entries, if available, to jump 2 fences at a required height (2'). To be judged on manners, willingness, suitability to purpose, and ability to give a safe, comfortable ride.

Over Fences (O/F)-To be shown over obstacles and fences which might be found on a trail. Height 2' for ponies and horses. To be judged on willingness and on natural ability to jump with emphasis on manners.

English Equitation Class Descriptions

Under Saddle (U/S)-To be judged equally on hands, seat, and control of mount and suitability to count. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. At the judges' discretion, other tests may be performed. **Martingales are prohibited.**

Over Fences (O/F)- To be judged equally on hands, seat, and control of mount and suitability to count. The over fences class fence heights shall be 2', 2'6" or 3'.

Hunter Class Descriptions

Over Fences (O/F)- To be shown over approximately 8 hunter type fences at the required height. Judged on even hunting pace, manners, and jumping style, together with faults and way of going over the course.

Under Saddle (U/S)- To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. **Martingales are prohibited.**

MHSA Regional Rated Classes

Exhibitors competing in classes restricted to amateurs must meet the requirements of USEF rule GR1306. Your signature as an exhibitor/ rider on the entry blank will verify that you understand and are in compliance with this rule.

MHSA Lead Line Equitation-Open to riders 7 and under as of December 1, 2018. (After December 1, 2019 riders who have turned 8 will not be eligible to compete in this class for the remainder of the Snowflake Series). Horses are not permitted. No martingales permitted. Riders may not enter any other **rated** classes except MHSA Short Stirrup Equitation. In the **unrated** ring, riders may enter the Lead Line and Walk/Trot Divisions.

Class No. 148 MHSA Lead Line Equitation Merit

MHSA Short Stirrup Equitation Division-Open to riders 10 and under as of December 1, 2018. (After December 1, 2019 riders who have turned 11 will not be eligible to compete in this class for the remainder of the Snowflake Series). Horses are not permitted. No martingales permitted in the Under Saddle classes. A rider may only **cross enter under saddle classes** in divisions where the fence height does not exceed 18".

Riders may not cross enter MHSA Low Pony Hunter and MHSA Pony Hunter Divisions at the same show.** Fence heights shall be 2', spreads not to exceed height of fence. No oxers may be used. Martingales are not permitted in the Under Saddle class.

At least ¼ of the class, but no less than 6 riders, will be selected to show at the walk, trot and canter (except the Children's Pony Medal). Same horse with same tack

must be shown in all phases (martingales are prohibited in the flat phase). Judges may ask for additional tests as they deem necessary.

You do not need to be a member of MHSA to enter the following classes. Exhibitors must be MHSA members in order for points to count for the respective medals. There will be no Snowflake Series year-end awards offered for these medal classes.

- Class No. 100 MHSA Gittings Horsemanship Equitation 3' (6 to fill the class)
- Class No. 117 MHSA Low Children's Hunt Seat Equitation Medal 2'6" (4 to fill class)

- **Low Children's and Low Adult will be combined if there are fewer than 4 entries in either of the classes.**

Unrated Classes and Divisions

Atlantic Hotel Classic-Sponsored by the Atlantic Hotel and the Charlie Purnell Family. Open to all riders on horses or ponies. The Classic will consist of one over fences round. Each rider will receive a score that will be announced following their round. Fences set at 2', 2'6", 2'9" or 3'. The Classic will be run as an open card throughout the day when fences are already set at the appropriate fence heights. **Riders may only compete in one classic per show.** The 10 exhibitors that have accumulated the most points after the February 2020 show will be invited to compete in the Atlantic Hotel Classic Finals on March 7th, 2020.

Class No. 102 Atlantic Hotel Classic Over Fences 2', 2'6", 2'9" or 3'

Indoor Mini Classic-Open to all riders on horses or ponies showing in the indoor ring, except short stirrup equitation and short stirrup hunter riders. The Classic will consist of one over fences round. Each rider will receive a score that will be announced following their round. Fences set at 18', 2', or 2'3". The Classic will be run as an open card throughout the day when fences are already set at the appropriate fence heights. **Riders may only compete in one classic per show.** The 10 exhibitors that have accumulated the most points after the February 2020 show will be invited to compete in the Atlantic Hotel Classic Finals on March 7th, 2020.

Class No. 169 Indoor Mini Classic Over Fences 18", 2', or 2'3"

Little Clovelly Farm Equitation Medal-Open to riders under the age of 12 as of September 1, 2019. To be shown at a walk, trot and individual canter both ways of the ring. Martingales are not permitted. Riders that show at fence heights greater than 18" are not eligible to enter this class. The 10 riders that have accumulated the most points in each medal class after the February 2020 show will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals on March 8th, 2020.

Class No. 160 Little Clovelly Farm Equitation Medal

AGS Equitation Medal-Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Class will consist of one over fences course. Fence heights shall be 2', 2'6", 2'9" or 3'. Run as an open card. The 10 riders that have accumulated the most points in each medal class after the February 2020 show will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals on March 8th, 2020.

Class No. 103 AGS Equitation Medal

Lead Line Equitation Division-This unrated lead line division is open to riders on ponies under the age of 8 as of September 1, 2019. Riders will be judged on their riding position, ability to control their mount, and basic knowledge of riding. Riders in this division may cross enter into the Walk/Trot Division. The MHSA Lead Line Merit class does not count towards the Lead Line Division.
