




#### Welcome to Your Faith Community!




#### ST. AUGUSTINE'S BAPTISM PREPARATION COURSE

### St. Augustine's Church has the following new parking rules:

- Do not park on the sidewalk or on the street in front of the church. There should be no cars parked from the Dominion Street entrance to Mountain Road.
- Do not park around the front steps (there are two parking spots by the side door on Mountain Road).
- Do not block other cars in the parking lots.

We received approval to use the parking lot at **536 Mountain Road (Youth Impact Jeunesse) for our weekend masses**. 536 Mountain Road is a one-story brick building with a Canadian flag on the roof and is the first building to the north of St. Augustine's Church on the same side of Mountain Road. The parking lot has room for 30 vehicles on both sides of the building. You can access the lot from two side streets: Shirley Avenue or Limerick Street.

For the 11:00am Sunday masses over the next several weeks, we will have people directing traffic to the appropriate parking lots and away from the front of the church.
