Invitation Letter – Friday, October 18th, 2019

Dear 9th Grade Band Students and Parents,

The time has come to reserve your spot as a participant in the 2019 9th Grade Band Cincinnati Tour. This trip features an exciting array of music education, music performance and fun! The music education highlights include a performance clinic with a professional conductor, and an opportunity to see the famed Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra in a live Performance.

The tour begins on Thursday morning, May 7, 2020 and concludes with the band's arrival back at Riverside late Saturday evening, May 9, 2020. As with any field trip experience, there are a number of important items that potential participants will need to know prior to tour commitment. This invitation letter is designed to

give each student and his/her parents all the necessary information needed to make a decision for participation.

Before we move forward with this invitation letter, we must be clear to parents and students that a band member can only travel to Cincinnati if he/she is present for **ALL mandatory state testing days preceding departure. We will ask that you acknowledge this on the **Tour Commitment Form**. **ALL** students, regardless of your decision to participate or not, must return the **Tour Commitment Form****

(last page of this packet). If your student is going, the deposit is due when the Tour Commitment Form is turned in.



As the tour draws near, we will have a parent meeting (two to three weeks prior to departure) to review the tour in greater detail. 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What does the tour look like?

For your convenience, We have attached to this invitation letter, our current *tentative* travel itinerary for May. Below are a few highlights. Who will be supervising the students? What about chaperones?

Mr. Draime and Mr. Schwartz will be chaperoning the trip this year. The primary contact for the trip is Mr. Draime. **We are looking for chaperones to travel with us on this trip to assist with student management, bus management and general activities.** We will take as many parents as we can. If you are interested in going on the trip, please fill out the attached form, return it and make a \$100 deposit. Space is on a first-come, first-served basis. If you have any questions about being a chaperone, please contact us.

As a student, what are my responsibilities regarding the tour?

First and foremost, it is important for each participating student to be aware that he must abide by all Riverside School District policies regarding behavior and conduct for the entire duration of the tour. The Riverside administration wishes to make clear that any infraction on this tour will not be tolerated. Second, we want to make all students aware that the code of conduct for this trip (which you will receive as the tour draws nearer) is also in effect for the duration of the tour.

ALL students are required to have all school work for all classes completed upon return Monday, May 11th.

Tell me about refunds.

Naturally, it is imperative that each family remains committed to this tour. However, unanticipated and rare events can occur which may adversely affect tour participation. We are stating, as concisely as possible, that the only way to qualify for a refund is to enroll in a travel insurance program. You can go to the Bob Rogers Travel website -- www.bobrogerstravel.com. At the bottom of the web page are two companies that will insure your trip. Please do not delay. Most companies require insurance to be purchased at the time of deposit or shortly after. FYI, about 10 people purchased insurance last year—one needed it and did not purchase it.

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What is the total cost and payment schedule?

We are thrilled to provide for each participating family a plan to make this trip more affordable. We have designed this plan to break up the total cost of the trip over a time period.

The total cost of the trip is **\$580.00**.

****Each year the Riverside Band Boosters commits \$50.00 to each participant's final cost provided that he/she participates in the Winter Citrus Fruit Sale by selling at least 5 items. That will take the cost of the trip to \$530.00. This deduction will be applied to the final payment of \$170.00, which will become \$120.00.**

There are two factors that will determine the final cost of the trip. The cost should not rise above \$580.00. The cost has never risen in all the trips we have taken. The first factor in the cost of the trip is the number of people attending. If more people attend than in our initial estimate, the cost of the trip will decrease. The other major factor is your student's participation in the fundraiser.

An individual final payment will be given to each individual for their final payment. Please do **NOT** pay in full on first payment. You may pay the first three at once. Please wait for a final payment sheet to finish payment.*

DO NOT SEND CASH OR CHECK! PAY ONLINE ONLY AT WWW.RIVERSIDEBANDS.COM. CLICK THE ONLINE PAYMENTS BUTTON ON THE LEFT SIDE. YOU WILL NEED TO SET UP AN ACCOUNT (unless you have an older sibling who already has an account from a previous trip). THIS IS A ONE-TIME SET UP. PLEASE REMEMBER YOUR LOGIN AND PASSWORD INFORMATION, AS WE HAVE NO ACCESS TO IT. THIS ACCOUNT WILL/CAN BE USED FOR MULTIPLE BAND ITEMS UNTIL YOUR STUDENT GRADUATES. (YES. IT SAYS DONATION. THAT'S OK.)

If you are purchasing trip insurance, go directly to www.bobrogerstravel.com and click on the insurance companies at the bottom left of the page. Just a reminder that if you are purchasing insurance, it must be done with or soon after the initial deposit.
