

Bear Bows for 1960 feature the famous and popular "Bear Flair" design. You see it in the poised-for-action shape of the bow limbs, the sculptured sight windows and the form-fitting semi-pistol grips. The "Bear flair" look represents much more than just beautiful bow styling — it means superior balance in the hand, sharper, smoother shooting plus all 'round owner pride and satisfaction.

Within this functional "flair" design is the dependability of glass-powered construction — pioneered by Bear and now perfected with amazing *Bearglas*.

The principle of glass-powered construction works this way: When a piece of material is bent, the outside stretches and the inside compresses. The center, or core, is neutral and does little work. The most efficient bow design employs high-strength material on the outside surfaces. Thus the center or neutral area can be a tough, light-weight material. The ancient Turks used this principle — a hard maple core backed with sinew and faced with buffalo horn. These bows shot distances unequalled to this day!


In a Bear Bow, the hard maple core provides the balanced lightweight body. The *Bearglas* face-and-back elements add the allimportant muscles.

Bearglas incorporates Fiberglas and a unique combination of plastic resins with tremendous adhesive qualities and great resistance to cold and heat. Under equal tension and lying perfectly parallel to each other, thousands upon thousands of closely packed continuous Fiberglas strands are bonded into a finished Bearglas strip.


Two strips are then laminated to the tapered hard maple core. Together, these elements provide the bow with magnum load hitting power and lightweight balance. The use of *Bearglas* adds years to bow life, as well — because it is unaffected by normal temperature and moisture variations.

This matchless construction, fully protected by Bear patents nos. 2,613,660 and 2,665,678 insures a "glass-power" element which makes Bear Bows favorites of expert archers and bowhunters everywhere.

Whichever Bear Bow you choose, you can be assured of the fastest, smoothest bow possible. In your skilled hands, this superb blend of grace and power is capable of mastering the toughest tournament or the most challenging big game.



New Bearglas face and back strips with tapered plies of hard maple electronically bonded between comprise the unique "sandwich" construction of all Bear Bows. This is the weight-saving feature that makes a Bear glass-powered Bow so pleasingly light and so perfectly balanced in the hand. Because of the unusual strength of Bearglas, the arrow is released with magnum load might...yet with unequalled smoothness and accuracy.



#### New Bearglas means more sustained bow power

Now, tough <u>Bearglas</u> develops still greater power-per-pound in the new Bear Bows. When the bow nears full draw, all of the countless glass strands are stressed, "sharing the load" uniformly. On release, the limbs spring into action with great speed, power and accuracy.

#### Getting to know your new bow

#### Choosing it wisely...

In your initial purchase of a bow the most important factor is its draw weight, or "pull". This is measured in pounds. It is the force required to draw the bow string to the length of a 28" arrow and is used as a standard because the arm span of the majority of adults is suited to this draw length.

Beginners often "overbow" themselves. This mistake can lead to poor shooting habits and lack of accuracy. As a general rule, select a bow about five pounds heavier than one you can draw back easily. Almost any bow will feel heavy at first because many otherwise unused shoulder and back muscles will be brought into play, but these respond quickly to practice.


In choosing a bow, seek experienced help from your Bear Dealer or from members of an archery club. Your own preference will develop as you become familiar with the sport. Start with a medium weight bow and get the best you can afford. In archery, as in all other sports, best results come from using the best equipment.

#### Most important: proper stringing technique...

The first step in archery is learning how to string your bow properly and safely.

Sketch A shows how to string a straight limbed or semirecurved bow such as POLAR, ALASKAN and PANDA. Slip one string loop over upper limb. Secure other loop in lower nock, using rubber band or bow tip protector. Place lower tip off ground against inside of right foot. With bow back toward you, place heel of left hand on upper limb below string loop. Simultaneously, pull bow handle back with right hand and push limb forward with left hand, sliding string loop up until it slips into upper nock. Firmly seat string loop in nock before releasing pressure. To avoid injury in case your hand slips, always keep your face turned away from the bow tip.

Recurved bows — KODIAK SPECIAL, KODIAK and GRIZZLY — are usually strung as shown in Sketch B. Secure one string loop in lower nock, using rubber band or bow tip protector. Step across bow with right leg so that bow handle lies high up behind right thigh. Grip limb with right hand just under recurve. Place lower recurve over instep of left foot, with bow tip off ground. Simultaneously, apply pressure on handle with right leg and bring upper limb toward your body by leaning forward from waist and applying pressure with right hand. Firmly seat string loop in nock before releasing pressure. To unstring your bow, reverse the procedures shown. Keep your eyes on lower tip to check string alignment and insure against limb twisting.



#### Adjusting your bow string...

The ancient method of measuring fistmele (or distance between the string and handle) has become obsolete on modern bows. Table below shows proper string distance from bow handle.

Try your bow at different spacings until you find smoothest shooting action.

When shortening a Bear string be sure to twist it in the *original* direction, otherwise servings may loosen. Use Bow String Wax to keep string in good condition (see Page 25).


A nocking point or locator knot made of thread or dental floss, insures proper arrow alignment. Nock Locks or Truespot Nocking Points (see Page 25) are useful for this purpose.

#### Care of your bow...

While not in use, keep your bow unstrung and hang it vertically or lay it across pegs which support both limbs. Insert it in a bow case and store in a cool dry spot — such as a closet next to an outside wall. As a rule, basements and attics may be too hot or too damp. When used in rain or snow, wipe your bow dry before storing.

In cold weather, flex your bow several times after stringing to "warm it up". Never draw it farther than the length of an arrow. Occasionally, apply a light coat of furniture wax to protect its finish. Always wax before applying tape of any kind—if left too long, tape may injure bow when it is removed.

The extremely sharp edges of broadheads or Razorheads are completely shielded by a protective cowl - guarding you against accidental injury as well. Points fit safely into a soft sponge rubber block. The open metal frame is sound-proofed with a resilient vinyl coating. Arrow shafts clip into a molded rubber holder which keeps the shafts apart and protects fletching.

For all its remarkable features, the Bear Bow Quiver is surprisingly lightweight. Your bow retains all of its balance and fast handling — characteristics necessary for smooth, accurate game shots.

# Bear BOWFISHING OUTFIT

#### Great sport for a small investment

There's no limit on action when you shoot rough fish with bow-and-arrow. It is good conservation and a lot of extra archery fun for you.

(Be sure to check your local game regulations.)

Actually, bowfishing provides many more game shots per hour than does the average deer hunt. That's one reason it's becoming so popular.

Near fresh water you can go after carp, suckers, buffalo, gar and dogfish. They present terrific targets when they're basking in the sun-warmed shallows on a spring or summer day. Down south, "shining" gar at night is popular in the bayous. Salt-water sportsmen can pit their skill against skates, rays and small sharks.

It's easy to rig your bow with a simple low-cost Bear Bowfishing Outfit. The lightweight stationary reel uses the spinning concept. The spool is 4¾" diameter and accommodates fifty feet of 90 lb. test Nylon line.



#### Selecting correct arrows for you and your bow

When ordering arrows specify the exact bow weight whenever possible (for example: 43 lbs. at 27" draw). Otherwise, specify 40-45 lbs., 45-50 lbs., etc., and the arrow draw length. Also, use the code letters on the chart (left) to show type of point desired.


There are two accepted methods used in finding your right arrow length. Method 1 is illustrated at the left below. Simply spread your arms as shown,

measure the spread and determine your arrow length according to the chart. The second method is shown below. Place the nock end of an arrow against the center of your chest and reach out on it with your arms extended straight in front of you. If the arrow is the correct length for you, it will extend to the end of the fingertips. Lacking an arrow, use a yardstick for this measurement.
