The Lake Champlain Race is MBBC's designated overnight race for the LCCS Cannon/Goose Series and one of the optional races for the LCCS Champlain Series.

First run in 1956, the original course was 117 nm long, starting and finishing at the club and running south to the Champlain Bridge and north to La Roche reef with lateral marks between. In 2000 the course was shortened to 102 nm by moving the start and finish to Stave Island and modifying some lateral legs of the course. In 2015 the the course was shortened to 62 nm by changing the southern leg to Quaker Smith Reef mark.

There is no skippers' meeting. Registration is at the Race Committee boat on the starting line. The RC boat monitors VHF channel 12.
