

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DELCAMBRE
FEBRUARY 11, 2019

Town of Delcambre regular session convened at 6:00 p.m. on FEBRUARY 11, 2019, at the City Hall, with Mayor Pam Blakely, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

- MEMBERS PRESENT: Members present: Alderman Bryan Glatter, Alderman Donald Martin, Alderwoman Madison Saunier and Alderwoman Sarah Trahan.
- MEMBERS ABSENT: Alderman Timothy Derise
- ALSO, PRESENT: Town Clerk Shirley Wyles, Town Attorney Ted Ayo, Fire Chief Brock Benoit, Police Street Commissioner Homer Stelly, Sellers & Associates representative Larry Cramer, Pelican Waste representative Tommy Thibodeaux and 16 guests.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to accept and dispense the minutes of the regular meeting of JANUARY 2019 as reviewed." Motion Carried:
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to authorize payment of monthly bills as reviewed." Motion Carried:
- DISCUSSION: Water Meter construction is going as scheduled with no major complications found per Street Commissioner & Engineers. Project is at 22% of completion.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to abide by Iberia Parish Ordinance for regulations regarding Recreation Vehicles within incorporated limits of Delcambre". Motion Carried:
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to approve a 4' property variance on the front set-back as requested by Bonnie Latiolais and daughter, Jessica Latiolais". Motion Carried.
- DISCUSSION: Mr. Robbie Fremin requested permission to dig a pond at 505 Lynn Street. Town Attorney, Ted Ayo, states "the Town has no ordinance in place at this time in reference to property owners digging/building ponds within the incorporated limits to Delcambre". Mr. Ayo also informed Mr. Fremin that "the Town of Delcambre abides by the rules of Iberia Parish for all permitting within the town of Delcambre due to the Parish issuing and inspecting on the Town's behalf". A copy of the guidelines for "Ponds or Berms" was provided to Mr. Fremin at this time by the Town Clerk. Mr. Ayo requested proof of subdivision rules should Mr. Fremin decided to move forward with the pond. Mr. Fremin responded to concerns of neighboring property owners in regards to safety and health hazards such as fencing, mosquitos and rodents with assurance of no such happenings. Mr. Fremin also responded to the Council members and Town Attorney in which he will 'personally contact Iberia Parish permit office first thing Tuesday morning in regards to permitting and guidelines as provided.

- DISCUSSION: Fire Chief Brock Benoit discussed the roof of the fire department building leaking and possibility of mold. The Council advised Chief Benoit to solicit three (3) bids for repair and bring to March's meeting for review and approval.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to inforce FEMA rules involving recreational vehicles within the incorporated limits of Delcambre". Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to approve the Street Commissioner to make inquiries of selling of or receiving credit(s) for old maintenance parts currently stored at the City Barn which have been deemed obsolete". Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to approve amending of the setback ordinance from 25' to 20'". Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to move into executive session". Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to resume regular session". Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to approve, upon recommendation of the Mayor, the termination of services with current CPA consulting firm, Langlinais, Broussard and Kohlenberg, effective immediately". Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Donald Martin "moved to approve, upon recommendation of the Mayor, the hiring of a new CPA consulting firm of Wright, Moore, DeHart, Dupuis & Hutchinson, LLC". Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "Moved to Adjourn." Motion Carried.
