## **Village Clerk Report - Heather Sherman**

- Received a quote to make four town signs in the amount of \$1600. Inquiring if they need to all be the same design or four different designs and if the cost changes with different designs.

- Long grass complaints are being addressed.

## **Water & Sewer/Streets & Alley Report – Derek Keutzer**
