Pandemic Protocol:

The faithful continue to be dispensed from their obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice. Those who are elderly, sick, or in a high-risk category are strongly encouraged to refrain from attending Mass.

Holy Communion is taken to the sick or homebound only by a priest at this time.

Arrangements are to be made with the parish priest when scheduling a sick call visit. Once Governor DeWine opens nursing home facilities to inside public visitation, Holy Communion can be taken to those in homes, facilities, and institutions. Kindly request any minister in the Communion line, holding a pyx and requesting Hosts, to speak with the priest celebrant after Mass in order that he can remind them of this temporary protocol.
