Laura (Braun) Edighoffer, age 89 of Bad Axe, formerly of Chandler Township, passed away Monday, Nov. 6 in the Huron Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

She was born July 13, 1900 in Atlantic Mine, daughter of the late William and Josephine (Poleglase) Tamblyn.
