For Junior Club Skaters

The North Shore Skating Club is pleased to announce a new program that will be beneficial to all who choose to participate!

Starting on Tuesday afternoon, September 26th, at the Hockeytown Rink on Rte. 1 South in Saugus, skaters who are members of the North Shore Skating Club’s “Junior Club Learn to Skate USA Program” currently taking group classes will have the opportunity to practice skating and have a coaching member of NSSC work with them privately at various times throughout the hour. Coaches will rotate around to each skater in an effort to help them perfect their skating skills. We feel this will be a very cost-effective way for our group lesson skaters to get needed practice time to help them advance through the badge levels while still ensuring that skaters are practicing their moves correctly. Basic Skills level skaters who are not currently taking group classes at the North Shore Skating Club may also participate in the program by joining our Junior Club at the membership fee of \$25.00 and paying the non-class rate.

Future sessions are tentatively scheduled for January 30, 2018 – April 17, 2018 and April 24, 2018 – June 26, 2018.

The guidelines for these sessions will be as follows:

- There will be a limited number of skaters allowed on the session
- Ability to contract these sessions will be on a first come, first served basis with preference going to Junior Club members currently enrolled in classes.
- Unless the ice is cancelled by the North Shore Skating Club, there will be no make-ups, credits or refunds for missed or cancelled “Pay in Advance” sessions. (Normally the North Shore Skating Club only cancels ice in the case of a severe weather emergency). Please call 781-944-5874 if you are unsure as to whether or not a session will be cancelled due to severe weather conditions. No switches to other session days will be allowed within the contract period.
- Skaters who are **not** currently enrolled in the North Shore Skating Club Junior Club may do so by paying the \$25.00 administration fee to join (\$20.00 if additional immediate family member).
- The “Pay in Advance” price will be pro-rated for those who start after the first week until the second to last week of the session only. There is no pro-rated amount for the last week of a 7 - 12 session.
- Both “Pay in Advance” and “Pay as You Go” skaters must complete the application form.
- Parents or guardians of all skaters must also complete the “Emergency Medical Form” and submit it with the application.
- Skaters who currently take private lessons must have their private lesson coach sign the application prior to enrolling in this program.

All payments are due in full prior to the start of the contract or in the case of “Pay as You Go”, prior to the skater taking the ice. Payments may be made by debit card, credit card cash, or check. Re-deposited or returned checks will be subject to a \$35.00 service charge. In the event that collection action is taken, the applicant will pay the costs of collection, including reasonable attorney’s fees.
