#### Dear Folks,



By now you have heard that I am leaving Aldersgate to take another appointment. It is important that you understand that this change was initiated by me.

For six years I have tried to help this wonderful congregation turn a period of declining numbers in to a time of increase and turn around. It is clear that I have not been successful in accomplishing this turn around. In light of the fact that I have done what I can and not certain what else might be done I consider it in the best interest of Aldersgate and myself to initiate a change.

This change does two positive things for Aldersgate:

- 1. It allows for the appointment of a new pastor who may be able to accomplish what I was unable to do.
- 2. It allows the finances of the church to be realigned so that it will be easier for the church to meet its obligations. You can operate at a deficit for only so long and then changes must be made.

So in answer to the question, "Why is Tony leaving?" the answer is simple; I am no longer an effective leader and I am too expensive for the current financial means of the church.

I hope and pray that this helps you to accept this decision with understanding and resignation. It is never easy for any of us when these things happen. We will have plenty of time to say our goodbyes and to prepare to enter the future with hope and confidence.

### A heartfelt felt heart


On Mother's Day, express your love for your mom or another special woman by giving her this gift from the heart.




