The following Project Proposal has been submitted to the City requesting TIF Funds. We have reviewed the application and offer the following overview of the project and it's economic impact in regard to potential TIF funding:

Project: Existing Building Renovation (Roof Repairs) for Existing Store

Developer/Contact Person: Emily Kerley

Approximate Project Address: 406 Court St., Vienna, IL

PIN: 08-05-430-008

#### **Project Description:**

The Developer plans to repair and seal the entire existing roof with a urethane and silicone system. Plans also call for the repair and replacement of damaged stucco and walls of the building.

The Developer has supplied an application document which describes the overall business model of Milkmaid Creations and outlined some of the finer details of the project.

It is the goal of the City of Vienna to encourage new development and support businesses that relocate within City limits. In fact, one of the main goals of the TIF program is to recruit & support commerce in the area so that the City can continue to prosper economically and grow tax revenues. The redevelopment of this commercial property is in line with these goals.

#### **Employment**

The Developer currently employs one person.

#### Sales Tax

The Developer estimates that this project will have \$35,000 in taxable sales annually, of which the City would receive 1%.

\$9,690 total costs Roofing Costs: \$6,690 Wall Repairs: \$3,000 +

All of the above mentioned costs could qualify as TIF Eligible under the Illinois TIF Act. This does not reflect the recommended assistance level or funding awarded. Please see "recommendation" for suggested assistance.

#### **Incremental Property Taxes**

Little additional property tax revenue is expected to be seen as a result of these improvements although the investment will certainly help to keep values declining at the property.

#### Recommendation

Unfortunately this type of renovation project is not likely to cause any significant increase in tax revenue for the City. Therefore, it will not generate much into the TIF fund for the City to both retain and reimburse the Developer. As a result the only viable means to utilize the TIF program in support of this project would be in the form of some sort of grant payment.

Therefore, if this project is desired to be financially assisted with the usage of TIF funds, it is our recommendation that the City considers offering the Developer a one-time grant of \$2,500 - \$4,500. This would be in addition to the Façade Improvement Application which the City can decide upon.

This recommendation is based on the investment in the property and additional property tax revenue. The City's involvement in the improvements is also good public relations to new businesses within the community and perhaps this support will stimulate additional redevelopment in Vienna. Any recommendation is subject to terms of an executed Redevelopment Agreement between the City and the Developers.



#### CITY OF VIENNA RESOLUTION 19-01

#### A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE USE OF PARK SHELTERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Vienna, Illinois, owns and operates park Shelters for public recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vienna, Illinois, establishes and administers rules, regulations, and fees for use of said Park Shelters.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VIENNA, ILLINIOS:

**THAT**, the following policies and fees be established:

- A. The City of Vienna, City Council has the legal authority to establish rules, regulations, and procedures for use of the City Park and Park Shelters.
- B. The following rental rules and priorities shall be established:
  - 1. Fees for Park Shelters that can be reserved during regular hours of operation shall be as follows:
  - a. Pavilion#1- Eagles Nest- \$20.00
  - b. Pavilion #2- Rams Lodges- \$20.00
  - c. Pavilion #3- Tecumseh Lodge- \$20.00
  - d. Pavilion #4-Cherokee Lodge- \$20.00

The rental fee includes any time frame within the available rental hours on a daily basis.

- C. The following rental rules shall be established:
  - 1. Shelters may be reserved up to one year in advance.
  - 2. Requests for private use of Park Shelters should be directed to the City of Vienna, City Hall at 618-658-5161 or by visiting http://www.cityofviennail.net under the contact us link.
  - Reservations will occur on a first come, first serve basis.

An official reservation can be made via city website, in person or phone call to City Hall accompanied by the full rental fee. If sending a check, payment must be received within (5) days before the rental date. Reservation inquiries may be made by contacting City Hall at (618) 658-5161. A rental/reservation receipt will be provided to you to confirm your rental/reservation. The City does not post reserved signs at shelters. Please retain your receipt for proof of reservation. Any reservations made before the passing of this resolution will be honored per the former fee.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Vienna as follows:


- **Section 1.** Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated herein by this reference as if specifically stated in full.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are herby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the City of Vienna, Illinois prior to the effective date of this ordinance.
