

Xfinity WiFi hotspots LOCATED IN BUSINESSES AND OUTDOOR LOCATIONS are available to anyone who needs them for free during the COVID-19 national emergency, including non-Xfinity Internet subscribers:

1. Go online to wifi.xfinity.com
2. Use 'Find a Hotspot' and enter your city or zip code
3. Go to location of hotspot

Look for "**xfinitywifi**" in the list of available networks on your device. Most are located in businesses and outdoor locations. Please follow health and safety guidelines, as outlined by health officials.

Note: If you are asked to pay for additional time, you are most likely logged into a residential hotspot, which are not a part of our COVID-19 open access.

You should see the following screen after selecting “xfinitywifi”



I've checked a few sites out, and found that the closer you get to the address listed, the better the signal. If you don't see the screen pictured above, you are picking up the wrong network and should probably try a different site. Some sites I tried that worked fine include the public parking lot behind the Snow Hill Post Office, on Green Street across from First Shore Federal Bank, on Pearl St. across from Taylor Bank, and in the parking lot at Mt. Zion Church on Dighton Ave.
