Piano Method A- any piece from lesson or supplementary books.

Faber Piano Adventures-Level 1

Alfred Basic- Level 1B

Hal Leonard- Book 2

Bastien Basic- Level 1

(or from similiar equivalent method levels)

Piano Method B- any piece from lesson or supplementary books.

Faber Piano Adventures-Level 2A/2B

Alfred Basic- Level 2

Hal Leonard- Book 3

Bastien Basic- Level 2

(or from similiar equivalent method levels)

Piano Method C- any piece from lesson or supplementary books.

Faber Piano Adventures-Level 3A/3B

Alfred Basic- Level 3

Hal Leonard- Book 4

Bastien Basic- Level 3

(or from similiar equivalent method levels)

Piano -Introductory Prep A- RC- check Royal Conservatory Syllabus for the Prep categories list of songs and method books of allowed pieces.

Piano- Introductory Prep B-RC-same as above (add Royal Conservatory link and state pages for the Prep categories)

Piano - Student's Choice (replacing the Open Categories)

Levels 1 thru 10 (any piece including Movie ,TV themes, Pop, Jazz, Blues, etc.) Use this category if the chosen piece does not fit in the other categories. Levels are approximate ie. Level 1= a piece approximate difficulty as a RC grade 1 piece.

Piano Duet/Ensemble- state approximate level. Ensemble can include piano with other instruments and also including voice.

Piano- Adult 18+ - Any piece, state approximate level. Maximum 2 pieces per student.

Piano- Sacred Solo- includes hymn arrangements, gospel, and worship songs. state approximate level of piece. ie. RC level 6

Piano- Christopher Norton - state grade level of piece. Any Christopher Norton piece from Royal Conservatory books, Connection series and any of his publications.

Piano- Original Composition- please provide adjudicator with a hand written notation of composed piece, it may also be produced by Composition software such as Finale.

Piano- Baroque Composers- composers such as Bach, Handel, Telemann, Scarlatti. Music from 1600-1760. State Royal

Conservatory grade. Use current RC Piano Syllabus. Pieces that have appeared in past Royal Conservatory books are allowed.

Piano-Classical Composers-composers such as Mozart, Beethoven, Haydn, Clementi. Music from 1730-1820. State Royal Conservatory grade. Use current RC Piano Syllabus. Pieces that have appeared in past Royal Conservatory books are allowed.

Piano- Romantic/Impressionistic Composers- Composers such as Chopin, Schubert, Schumann, Liszt, Brahms, Tchaikovsky, Ravel, Debussy. Music from 1780-1910. State Royal Conservatory grade. Use current RC Piano Syllabus. Pieces that have appeared in past Royal Conservatory books are allowed.

Piano- 20th Century, Canadian Composers, Contemporary-composers such as Bartok, Scott Joplin, Kabalevsky, Rachmaninoff, Shostakovich, Anne Crosby, Nancy Telfer. Music from 1900-present State Royal Conservatory grade. Use current RC Piano Syllabus. Pieces that have appeared in past Royal Conservatory books are allowed.
