

Yarrow



This perennial attracts butterflies and is known to be deer resistant. It is long-lived, trouble free and easy to grow. Yarrows are a larval host to 21 species of butterflies and moths. Birds will use the leaves of this plant to line their nests. The leaves have a pleasant fragrance and the flowers can be used in fresh or dried flower arrangements. This plant has a long medicinal history and is famous for its ability to aid in the healing of wounds.

Achillea millefolium

- Hardiness: Zone 3-8
- Size: 2-3'
- Flower: White flowers in mid to late summer
- Culture: Prefers full sun and well-drained soils. Drought-tolerant.
- Uses: Naturalizing, massing, border, care free, butterflies, birds, deer drought and air pollution tolerant, fragrant foliage, erosion control, edible, medicinal
