Ministry Position Descriptions

Building and Grounds	Helps to keep track of repairs and maintenance needed for the church property and brings such to the attention of the church body. Works toward finding the necessary help needed for such repairs
Children's Worship Worker	Provides teaching/instruction to children during Worship service
Fellowship/Social Events Committee	This committee will help to determine the various fellowship and social events for the year. They will not specifically plan the events; rather they will help to recruit and enlist individuals to coordinate the events.
Finance Committee	Help in proposing church budget for the coming year and in addressing financial matters for the church
Flower Committee	Helps to make arrangements for flowers to be sent to individuals during hospital stays and/or funeral situations
Food Ministry Committee	Helps to coordinate/organize meals for individuals following surgeries, extended illnesses, or childbirth
G.A.'s Worker (Girls in Action)	Assists the G.A.'s Director in conducting the G.A. program (Girls in Action is a missions program for girls Grades 1-6)
Greeter	Welcomes individuals coming to the Worship Service. Assists guests.
Mission Friends Workers	Assists Mission Friends Leader in conducting the Mission Friends program (Mission Friends is a missions program for pre-school aged boys & girls)
Money Counter	Helps in counting offerings and makes bank deposits
Nursery Helper	Helps in providing childcare during worship services
Nursing Home Ministry	Assists pastor with conducting services at local nursing home
OutReach Committee	Looks for and helps to coordinate opportunities in reaching our community for Christ. Helps to organize efforts in connecting with our community.
Puppets	Learns the techniques/skills in use of puppets for ministry
Pre-School Extended Session	Helps to provide teaching/instruction to pre-school age children during the Sunday Morning Worship service
R.A.'s Worker (Royal Ambassadors)	Assists RA's Leader in conducting the RA Program (Royal Ambassadors is a missions program for boy's Grades 1-6)
Sanctuary Decorators	Helps in decorating the sanctuary for seasons/holidays
Senior Adult Ministry Director	Helps to coordinate plan and organize special ministry events and fellowship activities for Senior Adults
Sound System	Helps to operate sanctuary sound system equipment
Sunday School Director	Serves as the general administrative leader of a church's Sunday School ministry.
Sunday School Teacher	Teaches/leads a Bible Study class on Sunday morning
Trustee	Serves as the representative for the church in signing legal documents
