Watering should take place during the morning or evening hours only. These water restrictions are in accordance to City Code 730.09 'Water Restrictions' and Code 120.01 'Violations and Penalties'. The cause for water restrictions are to help with water conservation and to limit operating costs to defer future modifications to the system.
