Minutes of March 1, 2021

The Huntington Township Trustees met in regular scheduled session at 7:00 PM at the Township Hall. Meeting called to order with the pledge of Allegiance by Robert Holmes. Also present were Jed Lamb, Walter Rollin, Dennis Finkel and Sheila Lanning.

Motion by Lamb with a second by Rollin to approve the minutes of the regular scheduled meeting February 15, 2021 meeting as written. Roll call: three yeas. Checks 9415-9439 and payments totaling \$16,909.18 approved for payment. *Motion* by Rollin with a second by Lamb to approve the February 2021 financial report with year to date revenue of \$60,285.02, expenditures of \$38,02.13 and bank balances of \$329,831.86. Roll call: three yeas.

Vacancies remain for alternate on the Zoning Commission Board as well as full member and alternate on the Zoning Appeals Board.

CDBG grant application should be for entire sidewalk from Cemetery to Township Buildings. Cemetery grant through Ohio Department of Commerce is only for the portion of sidewalk in the Cemetery.
