Rules and Information

Effingham Co Sportsman's Club Rules apply to all participants. Liability waiver must be signed if not a Member.

Unless modified herein, fundamental ATA rules apply for trap shooting, i.e. lost targets, failure to fire, etc. Management has final decision on all rules.

After last squad finishes 16 yd singles, squads for Handicap will be determined.

Handicap yardage will be based on shooters total score at 16yd.

Ties for Schuetzenkönig and Purse awards decided by shoot off. Shoot offs at Handicap yardage, 10 bird round.

Separate category and awards for Juniors, age 18 and below, entry fee \$20.

No special squadding for Juniors in singles or handicap events.

Lewis Class Rules:

Three classes Class payouts 1st - 50%, 2nd - 30%, 3rd - 20%, Ties divide.

Short classes head the list. Tie scores on class division lines go with majority, if equal they go to the lower class.

Awards:

Top Schuetzenfest member shooter receives an additional \$100.

Added prize money for youth donated by Mechanical Inc., and the Jessie Tedrick family.

Trophy winners will receive awards at conclusion of the event. Lewis Class payouts will be paid subsequently.

After Main Event concludes, Games, Annies, Protections, etc. will be shot.
