VALENTINE'S DAY REMINDER

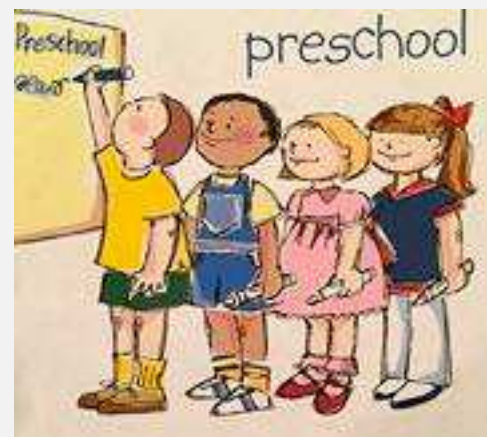
For our Valentine's Day celebrations (Feb. 13/14) we ask that you do your valentines in the following way: Please have your child sign his or her own name on the valentine (or if they cannot print their own name, print it for them) and put the card in an envelope.

****PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANY NAME ON THE FRONT OF THE ENVELOPE-JUST BE SURE TO INCLUDE ENOUGH CARDS FOR THE WHOLE CLASS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME SIGNED ON EACH CARD.**

Mrs. Cogan's AM-3 class: 11 cards; Mrs. Cash's AM-3 class: 8 cards; Mrs. Cogan's AM-4 Class: 11 valentines; Mrs. Cogan's afternoon 4 year old class: 6 valentines; Mrs. Bujno's AM-4 class: 12 valentines; (think about it a minute, they don't need one for themselves) We will have the children "deliver" the cards themselves by placing them in our Valentine's bags that we will make in class, and NOT having names on the front will make it much easier on us and the children.

Please DO NOT send in cards with candy, pencils, or other treats with the children. Thanks!! (The valentine cards that you can find at Walmart or a Dollar Store, or even cards that are homemade are just perfect)

Teaching our little Angels:

We encourage you to have your child take off and hang up his/ her **OWN** coat when you bring them to school. They are completely capable of doing it-in fact, they do it every day after playtime here at school. We simply remind them that it is their job to take off their coats and then hang them up, and they do it! Perhaps you don't even realize that you are taking their coats off of them and hanging them up for them, but several parents are. Other jobs that preschoolers can do: set a table, clear their places after meals, dust table tops, fold towels, pick up toys, make beds, feed pets. Giving children responsibilities like those listed above is beneficial to them, and lets them know that they are part of the family and that families work together.

DELAYED OPENINGS

Q) When do you close school or call a delayed opening?

A) We issue a delay or closing when weather conditions make transportation dangerous. We usually follow what the Hackettstown School District decides during inclement weather.

Q) How will I know if school is delayed or closed?

A) Call the school's answering machine after 7:30 am and a message about the status of school will be on it. You will receive an email and a Remind text if school is delayed or closed. You can also check out the school's Facebook page.

Q) What are school hours for a delayed opening?

A) For both 3 yr old and 4 yr. old AM classes, school will open at 10:15 and close at 12:15 pm. If our delayed opening is on a Wednesday, the MMO program will also meet from 10:15-12:15pm. Lunch Bunch on delayed opening days will be from 12:15-2:00 pm. Our 4 yr old afternoon class will meet from 12:45-3pm on a delayed opening.

Q) What if I can't get in to school?

A) We understand if you prefer not to drive in inclement weather.

OUTDOOR PLAYTIME

We love it when the kids can play outdoors-especially with our wonderful playground. A reminder that if the ground is clear of snow, and the temperature is at or above the 32 degree mark, we'll try to spend at least some time outside. Coats, hats and mittens are a MUST now! Please be sure to send them in with your child every day.



HEALTH ALERT!

It's been really tough out there this school year. Does your child have a slight fever? A runny nose? A bad cough? Are you wondering whether to keep him/her home? You probably should. We do have a definite rule here at Heaven Sent: if your child has had a fever, diarrhea or been vomiting, he/she cannot come to school until 24 (fever-free, diarrhea-free, or vomit-free) hours have passed.
