All participating horses must be AMHA registered. All horses must be measured or present a permanent measuring card issued by AMHA. Stalls are \$75.00 for the weekend. Camper hook-ups are \$35.00 per night. Valid AMHA registration, certification of veterinary inspection for stallions 3 years and older, coggins (current within 1 year), health certificate within 45 days on out-of-state horses, youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided. #### General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2023 rules and regulations of the AMHA. All horses must be registered with the AMHA.

This AMHA show has three judges. Points and awards will be awarded by each judge.

Awards will be given to 1st - 6th place. Championship ribbons will be awarded to Grand Champions.

Stabling: Stalls are 10' x 10'. No more than 2 horses per stall. Stallions 2 & older must be stalled separately NO

BEDDING IS INCLUDED WITH THE STALLS & NO OUTSIDE BEDDING MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS. Shavings are available for \$9.50. Showing off the trailer is permitted at a cost of \$20.00/horse. Please help keep the facility clean by putting trash in the

barrels and manure in the dumpsters.

Measurement: All horses must be measured before entering the show ring. Horses will be measured in accordance

with AMHA rules beginning on Thursday, March 9 from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and resuming Friday and Saturday mornings at 7:00 a.m. Hardhip measurements will be done during scheduled measuring

hours and/or immediately following the last class of each show day.

**Requirements:** registration papers. Entries submitted without registration papers will be held pending receipt of same. Each horse must have a current coggins. Out-of-state should bring original negative coggins report

(within one year) and health within 45 days.

Youth Classes: All youth must have an AMHA Youth number to be considered for National awards or titles. Youth card

applications are available at the Horse Show Office. Youth membership fee is \$10.00 or \$15.00 if

applied for at show.

Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are

Classes: \$15.00 or \$20.00 if applied for at the show. Applications are available from Show Manager.

Evaluation Forms:

Judge and Steward evaluation forms will be available at the horse show office.

<u>Liability</u> Statement: Southwestern Miniature Horse Club, its officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, driver, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at this show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY to this show or show grounds.

**Show Policy:** 

Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The show manager will notify AMHA of any such disqualification when the show results are reported.

**Pre-Entries**: Pre-Entries must be postmarked by February 25, 2023.

Added Classes: Added classes will be accepted up to four classes preceding the class to be entered.

**Refunds:** The SWMHC will give a full refund if entries are cancelled in writing by the pre-entry closing date. If

entries are cancelled in writing to the show manager and accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate of inability to show after the pre-entry closing date, but before the official start of the show (8:00 a.m. Friday, March 10) all fees other than the stall and office fee will be refunded. After the official

start of the show, there will be no refunds. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.

<u>Vendors:</u> The fee for commercial exhibitors is per day depending on the size of the booth and use of electricity.

Tables and chairs are not provided. Contact Show Management for a contract. Rates are as follows:

\$25 per day - 10 x 10 display or tent with no electricity \$35 per day - 10 x 10 display or tent with electricity
