Church Attendance Policy

All families must be registered in the Parish and regularly attending Mass at St. Bartholomew's. On-going consistent attendance at Mass throughout all years of instruction is necessary for a child to receive the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation. We determine if a child consistently attends Mass through the use of the children's envelope being deposited each Sunday and Holy Day. Envelopes may be deposited only by the child and not by a parent or a friend. A child occasionally attending Mass at another parish may bring in a bulletin signed by the priest at that parish to indicate attendance. If a child is sick and cannot attend Mass, a note from the parent will be accepted.

- 1. Parents are required to come into the school building to pick their child up at dismissal. Please park only in a designated space and do not leave your car running. Cars not in a designated/marked space will be asked to move. <u>Please exit the lot onto Palmer Road only.</u>
- 2. Children must arrive on time and stay for the entire class. Children who arrive late/leave early cause disruption to the class in progress. Children requiring the use of a bathroom during class time will need to make up work as class time is very limited. Please ensure your child uses the bathroom at home before leaving for class.
- 3. **NO GUM-** Cell phones are not permitted. If I see them or hear them, they will be confiscated and held for the parent to retrieve.
- 4. I use an automated call system for announcements & reminders. Please listen to the entire message as maybe the second part of a message pertains to you even if the first part does not. All messages are less than two minutes.
- 5. Children must bring their textbooks to class and come with a pencil/pen & notebook.
- **6.** Children are responsible for the material covered each week in class and unannounced quizzes may be given. If a child is absent they are responsible for finding out what material was missed, studying the material and completing the homework. An absence will not delay or be used as an excuse for not taking a test. **Absences my not exceed three classes.**
