**September 13, 2020**

**1st Reading Sir 27:30– 28:9  
[ The Need for Forgiveness]**

The Jews knew the directives of Sirach, and Psalm 103 (today’s Responsorial Psalm) as well as the challenge of Scripture to be holy as God is holy! “Wrath and anger are hateful things.” But they also had the civil law of talion: “An eye for an eye.” Many were selective. Soothing their consciences by selecting that civil law for personal behavior, they ignored the best in their Scriptures.


Christians are also tempted to be selective. We must realize that listening to this Scripture on Sunday and yet practicing any kind of Vendetta is inconsistent and un-Christian.

**Foundation of Theatines Order**

While attending Mass on Christmas Eve at the church of Santa Maria Maggiore in Rome, where St. Cajetan had celebrated his first Mass, a vision of Mary appeared to him in which she placed the Child Jesus in his arms. It was preceding this vision that St. Cajetan conceived the idea of an order of priests who would bring other religious to a more Christ-like way of life through active ministry and contemplative prayer. From these roots the Theatines have spread their message throughout Europe, to the East as far as India and Borneo, and West to Argentina, Brazil, Mexico, and the United States; all the while zealously following their motto, Quærere primum regnum Dei – Seek first the Kingdom of God.

For over 100 years the Theatine Fathers have been serving the faithful of Colorado, ministering to souls and making boundless contributions to the historical and cultural elements of what defines the colorful state. With numerous parishes in Colorado and one parish previously in the state of New York, the Theatines have unrelentingly worked in the United States through their initial mission to attend to the spiritual needs of Italian and Spanish speaking Catholics. The Order Clerics Regular, also known by the common name “Theatine,” a name derived by members of the order from the ancient town of Theate (Chieti) in Italy, was founded in 1524 by Saint Cajetan.
