Message From The Board

Since the last time I wrote we have incurred "Irma". I hope you have fared well during this terrible storm. I was fortunate to have incurred no damage to my home. The day after the storm, I attempted to make my way to the Lodge but was turned back because the roads near the river were impassable due to flooding. A few hours later I received a call from Judy N who told me that Pete, our Lodge Secretary was able to get to the lodge and found that a water pipe had burst and was shooting water into the air.

Walt LaCombe and I returned to the Lodge and found the source of the water. We were able to shut it off and then looked around at what appeared to be extensive damage caused by the wind which knocked down our treasured banyan trees, one of which had completely covered two of our maintenance sheds and together with the wind had folded the roof back and blew in the doors to the Elkette's shed. Initially, I was overwhelmed by the extent of the damage and had visions of our Lodge being closed for several weeks. The next day I returned and found Jenny and Sharon already at work raking the pathways, creating piles of debris and the damage looked far less. We examined the cabins and found no damage, we examined the lodge and because of the preparations made by the volunteers prior to the storm there was minimal damage to the building (only a small leak through the flashing on the vents}. The dock sustained some repairable damage but our seawall sustained several sink holes and were repaired quickly. There was no power so we rented a generator for the office, and we kept the doors closed and sealed for our refrigeration units and freezers. Many volunteers came to help when they were able, Rogers Landscaping and Tree Service removed the trees, cleaned up the area and made it safe for our staff and employees.

When the power was restored on Thursday we made the decision to re-open the Lodge and get everyone back to work. We opened on Friday with a limited menu and our first fish fry. I have to say that without the dedicated officers, directors, staff and volunteers we would not have been able to open as quickly as we did. A big Thank You to everyone who helped.

We enjoyed a successful Labor Day picnic with festive decorations and music. Our PER Octoberfest was well attended and everyone enjoyed the meal and the music by Barbara Mendillo. This is a fundraiser for the PERs and the money is used for scholarships and other charities.

We will be having our usual Thanksgiving Dinner; make your reservations early. The annual Christmas Party tickets are available and remember this is a targeted fundraiser for our local needy families. They are \$30.00 and available at the Secretary's office. New Year's Eve tickets at a cost of \$60.00 each will also be available at the Lodge on November 14th 8:00 a.m for our Lodge members (cabin rental office after 10am) and on November 15th for all other Elk members. We will be dancing to the music of Verceal. Get your tickets early.

Our membership has continued to grow and the new members bring enthusiasm and excitement to our Lodge. Please remember that our Lodge is the friendliest Lodge on the Peace River and this is to remind us to be friendly to these new members and treat them with welcoming smiles. Encourage conversation and comradery. Please be mindful at how hard our staff works to please us and do their jobs. Respect for each other is a mandate at our Lodge. Be patient and know that staff are doing their best to expedite your service. As always, the Board and I wish to encourage you to support the Lodge by attending our functions, using our restaurant and bar and helping when you can because any profit that we obtain supports our Lodge property and our charities. We are constantly aware of the needs in our community and are finding new ways that we can help and support them.


