All funds raised support local education, screening, and diagnostic programs and global research efforts to find the cures.

Online registration is available through May 3rd. Registration fee for adults and survivors/living with metastatic breast cancer is \$25; under 18 years of age is \$10 and virtual participants are \$40. Day of walk registration is \$35 for adults, \$15 for youth. The registration fee provides each walker with an event t-shirt and surprise gift to be used during Opening Ceremony.

Fundraising is not required but is encouraged since registration fees simply cover the cost of the event.

















