

Martha E. Bullock Memorial Park Deadwood, South Dakota



Elevate Design Studios worked close with the city of Deadwood on the revitalization of a historic park. The design of the park went through several variations looking at different types of uses and play. Considerations were made for type of play equipment, sports fields and courts, ice rink, and passive amenities. The final design chosen provide a variety of uses for the park with the ability to be flexible with developing usage of the park throughout the year.

The City of Deadwood invested over \$305,000 to complete the improvement project on the Park. Improvements to the park will include, a new trolley stop along HWY 85, welcome plaza, plantings, tennis/pickle ball court, playground equipment, shelter, sledding hill, and parking. Elevate Design Studios along with the City worked with the Deadwood elementary second graders to select the playground equipment.
