Councilman Stroupe made the motion to add Councilman Ford and Councilwoman Gibson to the signature pages of the RIA/CDGB grant accounts. Councilman Janesky seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Police Chief Ham gave an update on the Police Department everything is running the same.

Fire Chief Ford gave an update on the BVFD; he stated that the fire department would be involved in passing out smoke detectors to the community.

PWD Smiley gave an update on the Welcome Center Sewer Project: that it is proceeding as planned.

Interim Administrator Foster stated the administration department is doing well.
