television shows. One example is a show called "Monk".
The main character is an obsessive-compulsive detective.

I like the slogan because it communicates to me that all people are welcome. I believe that phrase captures the heart of Jesus. While the religious leaders rejected lepers, tax-collectors, Samaritans, and Gentiles, Jesus welcomed characters of all kinds.




# "In dependence" Day!

Create this colorful July 4th craft.

#### What you need:

- Decorated card stock square (5'x 5"
- Scissors
- · Hole punch
- 2 one-inch circles of card stock
- Glue
- Pipe cleaner (3 inches)
- Drinking straw

#### What you do:

- Fold the square corner to corner to form an X. Unfold.
- To make spokes, cut the four creases until an inch from the center.
- Punch a hole in the middle of the square, near the tips of each spoke, and in the middle of each circle.
- Fold each spoke toward the center, lining up the holes. Glue in place.
- Wrap one end of the pipe cleaner around the top of the straw. Thread a circle, the pinwheel, and the remaining circle onto the pipe cleaner.
- Roll the pipe cleaner end into a ball. Then spin!

Congratulations to Eric Cramer and Jo Beth Strong on joining the family of Aldersgate UMC.


On Sunday, June 16th at the 11 am worship service, Eric and Jo Beth became professing members of the family of God.




