



FACT SHEET – VISITOR EXPECTATIONS

Visitation is allowed for all residents at all times

Visitation will be outdoors, weather permitting & indoors in the visitation area on the first floor

ALL visitors are screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, including temperature check, screening questions/assessment. Visitation will be refused if the individual(s) exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or does not pass the screening questions. A rapid test will be offered/done on the date of the visit as part of the screening

Visitors must wear a face mask or covering that covers the nose & mouth, at all times when on the premises of the nursing home & maintain distance from other visitors, staff and residents.

Visitors must limit their interaction to only the resident they are visiting and not visit multiple residents at a time.

One visitor (preferably fully vaccinated) may go directly to the resident room and assist the resident in coming to the visiting area on the first floor after they have cleared the screening process and the unit has been contacted

No more than 3 persons are allowed in the elevators at any given time, so please be mindful of this of you are assisting the resident in coming to the visitation area.

All visitors will be required to adhere to Midway's infection prevention policies as posted and the directions of the staff which include but are not limited to: use of hand sanitizer, hand hygiene, physical distancing and use of facemasks

If a resident is unable to leave their room for visitation, special arrangements will be made so as not to interfere with the safety and well being of the resident being visited or roommate(s), if any.

Distancing, as marked in the visiting area, must be always maintained.

Food & beverages may not be consumed by visitors during the visit as this would require mask removal.

Please keep your loved one's routine in mind when coming for a visit and if you will be arriving between 9 PM and 7 AM, please call ahead so that we can alert security.

If any visitor tests positive or is quarantined due to COVID exposure in the 14 days following visitation, the facility must be notified immediately.
