The Georgia Strawberry Festival is sponsoring a "Mad About Strawberries " Art Contest. This contest is open to Taylor County School District K-12 students. Each submission must feature a picture of a strawberry or strawberries.

After all submissions have been collected, a teacher from each classroom/homeroom will select 3 drawings to be given to the school principal. The principal or principal's committee will select the one best drawing of their choice for each grade level.

The selected drawings will then be turned over to the Strawberry Festival Committee to decide the overall winner. All art submissions must be turned in by April 20, 2018.

Artwork that has been selected for judging will be featured April 28th, 2018 during the Georgia Strawberry Festival at the Flint Maintenance Building for the "Mad about Strawberries" Art Show.

If your student is interested, please follow the guidelines below:

Artwork should meet the following expectations:

- Include students name, age, grade, and classroom teacher's/homeroom teacher's name on front of paper
- Include drawings of a strawberry or strawberries
- Be original and not copied from another source
- Be in color or black/white.
- Be on unlined paper furnished by the Strawberry Festival Committee.

Drawings should be given to teacher or front office by the end-of-the-day on Friday, April 20, 2018.

Winner will receive a prize from the Georgia Strawberry Festival.
