## Block 1

fabric required:
background (yellow)
(1) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strip
(4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares
medium (green)
(2) $5 \frac{114}{}$ " squares
medium (orange)
(4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares
dark (blue)
(1) $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strip
(1) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square


Let's start:
group 1
gather the background strip and the dark (blue) strip right sides together, stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam down length of strip press to the dark side and recut every $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ( 8 total)
 pair up to make (4) sets of patches and stitch together the pairs press to the dark side

## group 2

(2) medium (green) $5 \frac{114 "}{4 \prime \prime}$ squares
(4) medium (orange) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(4) background (yellow) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares
*right sides together, place 2 (orange) small squares on top of large square draw diagonal line across 2 small squares
stitch a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from each side of the line and cut on drawn line press towards the smaller triangles
right sides together, place another (orange) small square on the large triangle
draw diagonal line
stitch a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from each side of the line and cut on drawn line.
press towards the smaller triangle
repeat with remaining large triangle
makes 4 flying geese
starting at the * repeat directions using the (4) yellow small squares and the large green square.
stitch the background (yellow) small triangles on top of the medium (orange) small triangles, make (4) sets.


Putting it all together:
