- 1. Roofing is no small project, there will be constant noise from start to finish.
- 2. We will need to access your driveway. If possible please park cars, boats, etc., out of the driveway area.
- 3. Please remove all items from around the outside perimeter of the home where roofing debris could potentially fall. This includes patio and pool furniture, potted plants, etc.
- 4. Please keep all children and pets away from the materials, trucks, trailers and ground below the repair area.
- 5. Please remove all breakables from walls and shelves. Vibrations from roofing work may cause loose items to fall.
- 6. A magnetic nail roller will be used to pick up any nails that might have fallen while we were working. We will make an honest effort to pick up all nails and debris however, please know that nails may get hidden in the grass or shrubbery.
- 7. Upon completion of the work if our crew is allowed access to the attic we will check your heating unit, hot water heater and stove vents in the attic to insure nothing has become dislodged while we were working.
