I am writing this letter to you in the second quarter of the year 2016. We had a tremendous year in 2015 with many trials, tribulations and with many victories. Coming into this year with the largest number of various decisions for Christ in one year, approximately 304 through the efforts of three evangelistic ministries. We are attempting to get ready for the first Semester of the academic year 2016 for Liberty Theological Seminaries International classes. We have no other choice but to follow the orders of our great King in response to the marching orders he has given us. Every week new people are getting saved. This type of the moving of God's Holy Spirit makes my day.

Both Esther and I have gone through some trials with medical issues but God is helping both of us and many are praying for us. When Esther found a hard place on her breast, it was discovered that it was fluid. Then following that she had several days of oscillating up and down fever, it was treated with medication. I am doing much better with my neuropathy and both of us are declaring our healing.

Personally our personal budget is tight because of the small out of the pocket expenses that everyone has. In this area we are waiting on the secondary insurance, Washington State National Insurance Company to reimburse us. Also, the cash offerings for Alabama Prison Ministries have been half of what is necessary for us to operate effectively. We must have \$2,500.00 per month to fully operate the ministry and meet all of our obligations.

We have confidence that the God who has always supplied our needs for over twenty years will do so again. We will continue to communicate our needs in various areas of our ministry efforts to you in a series of E-Newsletters.
