Typically, the intake process includes outreach, a basic assessment, initial system intake, and program referral or program placement

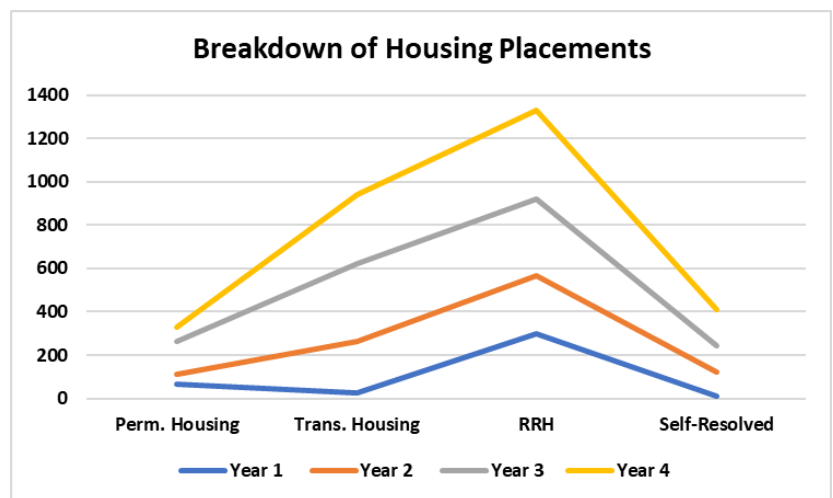
