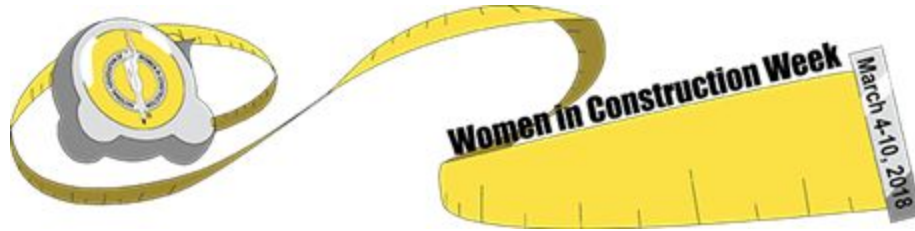
### Tuesday, March 6<sup>th</sup> 5-7PM - Volunteering with Food Bank for the Heartland
