vitally important to raise your standard of spiritual excellence according to the Word of God.

Unfortunately, many are often plagued with twisted thinking or lack of knowledge about the kingdom of God. They try to walk in the paths of righteousness, although they practice the kingdom of this world's principles.

Your life will never parallel the righteousness of God if your beliefs are not deeply rooted and grounded in the Word of God. The anointed Word of God is capable of bringing clarity in every area of your life. By raising the bar, you will find your quality of life will also improve. The life and power within the Word of God is so sharp that it can cut a precise line between the soul and spirit, and between what are mere thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Be determined to discover the truth in the Word of God about the most significant trust factors. First, believing God is who He says He is, has what He says He has, and will do what He says He will do. Secondly, believing you are who God says you are, have what God says you have, and can do what God says you can do.

Your perception of those persuasions is evident by your assumed posture as a king, servant, or slave. That same image determines whether you are ruling over, laboring under, or bound to your circumstances. I Chronicles 14:2 unmasks King David's struggle and triumph with his own self-image. "And David perceived that the Lord had confirmed him king over Israel, for his kingdom was lifted up on high, because of his people Israel." David was anointed

king. He wore what a king wore. He lived where a king lived. He even acted like a king. However, David's life was totally transformed the moment he received the revelation that being king was God's idea.

Just like David, when you perceive the Lord has made you to reign like a king, your approach to life will remarkably change too. It will be much more than a title. It will be much more than a signature. You will find that it uniquely encompasses the personal worth and value you behold through the eyes of the King of kings. Once you accept your royal authority, your identity crisis will be cured, as well as, how you identify with God.

Now Jesus Christ was convinced God had ordained Him as the King of kings. He proved His authority by taking the reins over angels, satan, demons, sin, sickness, death, weather, animal kingdom, birth defects, debt, and over every impossibility during His earthly ministry. After Jesus ascended into heaven, He then sent the Holy Spirit to empower you to reign victoriously in all those same areas. You can be fit to wear the crown comparable to Jesus Christ and even do greater works as the Bible prophesies.

Because Jesus indwells you through the power of the Holy Spirit, you can maintain a smooth transition from coronation to the throne. II Corinthians 3:18 confirms the Holy Spirit's role in qualifying you to operate under the authority of His anointing. "But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass [transparency] the glory of the Lord, are changed [transformation] into the same image from glory to glory, even by the Spirit of the Lord."

After diligent search of the Scriptures, I found myself in there. Humbly yet boldly, I pronounce God has crowned me king. I have entered into God's court with praise as a ruler of all His substance. With confidence I now acknowledge my own name in the place of the word "king" in the following verses because God has raised me up to sit in heavenly places in Jesus Christ. "The king shall joy in thy strength, O Lord; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he rejoice! Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah. For Thou preventest [anticipated his request, so prepared the answer] him with the blessings of goodness: Thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head. He asked life of Thee, and Thou gavest it him, even length of days for ever and ever. For Thou hast made him most blessed for ever: Thou hast made him exceeding glad with Thy countenance. For the king trusteth in the Lord, and through the mercy of the Most High he shall not be moved," Psalm 21:1-7. It's the righteousness of God to reign like a king!

Psalm 106:4-5

Mary and all the others in attendance were visited by the shepherds after the birth of Jesus Christ. Luke 2:16-19 records this account. “And they [the shepherds after having an angelic visitation] came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger. And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child ‘For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord, Luke 2:11.’ And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds. But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart.”

Now one would imagine being in the same place at the same time that everyone should have believed the same presuming they all saw and heard the same things. Unfortunately, that was not the case. Mary pondered all the things she heard. When the angel first announced the birth of Jesus Christ, that's when Mary received Him as the Royal Seed in her heart. She received the full manifestation of His birth by faith before she ever laid eyes on Him. Luke 1:38 recalls her

personal account with the angelic being, "...Be it unto me according to Thy Word".

The dictionary defines "ponder" as to premeditate, calculate, respond intentionally, plan for the expected event, and to believe on purpose. Mary believed the best therefore she received the best. Ultimately, Mary realized the royal authority God ordained for her. According to the power that worked within her, the virgin Mary made room for the unsolicited and the unthinkable, Jesus Christ, the Son of God when the Holy Spirit came upon her and supernaturally sowed the Royal Seed in her womb.

All the others around Mary only wondered about the things the shepherds said. The dictionary defines the term "wonder" as to doubt, speculate, or guess because of not being sure. Questioning the whole matter they probably were asking themselves, could this really be? That's impossible! I have to see it to believe it. They couldn't envision it in their hearts because it was unrealistic to them.

Faith in God is the only way to access the kingdom of God. It is that kind of faith that takes you to the highest place because you have been created to believe to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. If you rely on seeing everything physically first, you will also have to depend on what you can produce alone. In other words, you will idolize yourself as your own god.

Just like Mary raised Jesus in the steps God ordered, you can empower Jesus to rise up and live big within you to order your steps in the paths of righteousness. Mary looked beyond

her lowly state to receive the gift of righteousness. Offering herself sacrificially, she willingly stepped away from her comfort zone to receive heaven's most priceless treasure Jesus Christ, God's gift to the world. You too are blessed and highly favored to demonstrate the exceedingly, abundantly above all your hopes, dreams, and plans, but first be willing to open up your heart to receive the unseen things of God.

As the truth of God's way of life unfolds in the following pages, make room to embrace His vision and provision. As Joshua 1:8 coaches, meditate on the laws of God all the time so you can make your way prosperous and have good success. I believe you will know what to do with the Royal Seed that has been deposited in you. You will enthroned Jesus with the royal authority He desires to fulfill God's earthly mission through you.

Enthroning vs. Dethroning God

*"I have set the Lord always before me:
because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved."*

Psalm 16:8

Believing something other than what God says is truth is disbelief. This accounts for many believers being overthrown by their own circumstances. If you do not constantly deposit the Word of God in your heart and confess it with your mouth, then satan will exercise dominion against you. Left in that state, the authority of every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God cannot be fully actualized in your life.

Let's look at the four varying points of view about reigning with Jesus Christ. In any given situation it is possible for any one of the four positions to be your chosen alternative.

Unbelieving-unbelievers never reign with Jesus at all. They believe the idea of reigning is an activity they should never engage in at all because they cannot see it. Viewing it as blasphemy, the enemy confiscates this truth without any resistance at all because the Word of God is not a present, active force in their life. To them the mere thought of reigning in Jesus' stead is exaggerated because there is no visible evidence. Because of this wait to see mentality they have undeveloped faith. Failure to exercise the authority and power of God yields no restoration for them.

Believing-believers anticipate reigning with Jesus later. They focus on having a better tomorrow when they get to heaven, but they never use their authority to enjoy the days of heaven upon the earth. They believe they aren't going to reign with Jesus until His Second Coming, so they wait for God to do everything because they are distracted by the cares of this world and the lusts of other things. They won't actively participate in God's plan and purpose for their life. They are established in the hope of things to come instead of "now faith is". They operate with little power, bringing about little restoration for their lives.

Unbelieving-believers tend to remove the royal crown at times. They are tossed between believing what the Word says is truth and accepting contradictions when the trial of their faith is pressured. They believe they have this authority

and power now with Jesus, but only exercise it with strict limitations because of tradition or some form of mockery. They are prone to give up their rights to the devil, never standing their ground. They easily succumb to defeat because they think it is suffering for Christ's sake. In reality, they needlessly endure the misery from their own insecurity while placing the blame on offense and persecution. Therefore, they operate with sporadic power resulting in an inconsistent pattern of restoration.

Receiving-believers make reigning with Jesus their lifestyle in the here and now. They don't faint, cave in or quit, but believe to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Their faith is locked into the Word of God. They focus on receiving the promise of reigning by faith. They always see the promise as a finished work, not a piece of work. They see themselves sitting next to Jesus Christ in heavenly places wearing the crown even if no one else sees it. They are fully persuaded of their power and authority in Jesus Christ now. They embrace their authority in Christ by ruling their situations and not allowing circumstances to dictate to them. They confess their kingship so they rule and settle all outstanding matters as quickly as possible because the Word of God is a present, active force in their life. They experience restoration to the fullest now as God envisions because they thank Him for receiving things they cannot see. I Peter 1:6-8 clearly speaks of them. "That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: whom having not seen, ye love; in whom though now ye see Him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of

glory: receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls."

One of the four purposes for the Scriptures is for "instruction in God's righteousness" as documented in II Timothy 3:16. God has given us His Word as a teacher and according to Ephesians 4:1-13, the Lord also gave us the 5-fold ministry gifts "for the perfecting of the saints, for the edifying of the body of Christ: till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ."

Although righteousness endures to all generations, it begins the moment you accept Jesus Christ as your Savior. The more you mature in Christ, the more of the reins you should be willing to grant Him. Changing your spiritual diet from milk to meat will help you grow up in the things of God. Then having learned to transfer your trust to God, the Holy Spirit can lead you in the paths of righteousness more fully which manifests royal authority.

Royal authority enthrones Jesus as Lord in your life, not just Savior. All claims of royal authority voluntarily empower Jesus as Lord. There is absolutely no motive to remove Him from anything at all. The intent is to include Jesus Christ in every decision and every judgment made all the time. Royal authority solely depends on the Lord as its source to choose the best.

On the other hand, blasphemy dethrones Jesus with the motive to reign independently without Him. One indelible

example is when satan conspired to overthrow God. satan and one-third of the angels [now demon spirits] were thrown out of heaven before the revolt could be carried out. Isaiah 14:12-15 reveals satan's desperately wicked heart when he attempted a *coup d'etat*. "How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit." In that case, no weapon formed against God as King of kings, and Lord of lords prospered. satan's tongue failed because he could not do what he thought he could do.

Meekness is royal authority's greatest strength because it is that character trait that is present in the life of a believer that inherits the earth and delights in the abundance of peace as recorded in Psalm 37:11. Contrarily, pride is royal authority's greatest weakness because it comes before failure and destruction. Your greatest strength can only become your greatest weakness when you stop doing your greatest strength.

God has given you royal authority to master your own environment. God already recognizes and accepts it in heaven and in the earth. Now all you have to do is to apply the authority and power within and release Him to work mightily through you.

Storm the gates of hell and restore everything that has been lost, stolen, or destroyed. I pray you will become an active part of the remnant that reigns so satan still can't do what he thought he could do in the earth. It is your choice whether or not you experience breakthroughs like a king, bend like a servant, or break like a slave.

Covenanted from the Cross to the Crown

*"...Yet He hath made with me an everlasting covenant,
ordered in all things, and sure;
for this is all my salvation, and all my desire..."*

II Samuel 23:5

Begin to look through the blood of Jesus if you want to have a precise view of your life as God sees it. Through Adam "all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God," Romans 3:23. God never leaves you short of anything. Therefore there is no excuse that can hinder you from having an intimate fellowship with God. You are not a sinner saved by grace. Your can't be crowned and "crown-less" at the same time. You have been made the righteousness of God through Jesus Christ. Because of this, the blood of Jesus Christ settled every debt you owed once and for all. Once you receive the benefits of the cross for yourself you are preserved blameless. Your past, present, and future are under the Blood when you simply ask for and receive forgiveness. As you mature, you will learn to pass up opportunities to come short of the glory of God. Instead you will stand faultless before God's glory. "Now unto Him that is able to keep you

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RULER OF ALL GOD'S SUBSTANCE

Power Legally Transferred

"Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear son:"

Colossians 1:12-13

Endeavor to completely understand the historical events behind legally transferred power so you can reach clarity about your role as the ruling righteous today. God originally ordained Adam and Eve as the rulers of this earth to exercise dominion over everything He created. God empowered them with indisputable influence with the following directives found in Genesis 1:28. "...Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth." In other words, everything that swims, flies, and creeps (even the creep, satan) govern it all. In *The Living Bible*, Genesis 1:26 says, "to be master of all life upon the earth and in the skies and in the seas."

God also gave them a command to "subdue". The *Scofield Reference Bible* defines it as, "to acquire the skillful knowledge necessary to master the material environment to serve the races". In other words, master your God-given inheritance,

the earth and the fullness thereof, so the presence of God can prevail in everything.

Realize the awesome power and authority Adam had before the fall. In the beginning, God made Adam in the image and likeness of Himself as the Father, Jesus Christ the Son, and the Holy Spirit. God did not leave Adam powerless but made him more than a conqueror as the earth's ruler with the backup of heaven.

Just one act of disobedience caused Adam to overthrow the entire kingdom of God in the earth. Adam committed high treason, which is when a government is overthrown by one of its citizens. Adam knowingly rebelled against the kingdom of God ultimately overthrowing his own position and generations following as ruler of the earth as well as God's opportunity to enthrone the earth. I Timothy 2:14 confirms this, "And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression."

Adam's infidelity drove him to worship satan, lawfully positioning the devil as ruler of the earth. Along with the legal transfer of authority went all the other rights and privileges of the earth to the god of this world system.

The result of just one act of rebellion established the kingdom of this world along side the kingdom of God on earth. Because of this, there is now a choice of two gods to serve: the Almighty God or satan.

God could have reacted by violating His own law to put things back in order. Instead, He chose to abide within His

law to show satan He would win in the end, as well as, still have our freewill worship. The devil thought restoration was impossible but he was surprisingly mistaken because he was ignorant of God's unseen plan of salvation.

God reversed the curse of the law through Jesus Christ's sacrifice. We give thanks to God who always causes us to triumph through the blood of Jesus Christ. The devil was legally demoted and his kingdom, the world system, legally condemned when Jesus purchased our salvation on Calvary and restored all our rights and privileges. The Resurrection repositioned Jesus Christ and the Church as the earth's ruler again.

With just one awesome act of obedience, Jesus, appointed by God, restored the kingdom of God to its rightful state and returned to the rightful hands, you and me as rulers of the earth. The transfer has already been granted to us with the original commandment in Genesis 1:28. The earth is within your circle of influence.

The power we now have is greater than what Adam had originally because Jesus enthrones our heart. When you develop confidence and boldness to master your territory, satan will think it's Jesus instead, because of the authority of the anointing that abides within you. Jesus rendered satan powerless and his authority has been totally surrendered. Believers now can reclaim territory for the kingdom of God so the power of God can be released in the earth. What will you do with the royal authority you have within?

The Kingdoms of our Lord and His Christ

*“...the kingdom of God suffereth violence,
and the violent taketh by force.”*

Matthew 11:12

The kingdoms of this world are satan's to give away. Through a cycle of temptation, satan made an appealing offer to Jesus Christ to *give* Him the kingdoms of this world. This word “give” means to exchange for Jesus' worship. In an attempt to overthrow the kingdom of God, satan was going to deceitfully empower Jesus with fleeting world power. Like our Father can give the kingdom of God away, well satan as ruler of the kingdoms of this world system can give his away to those who serve him.

The defeated foe, satan, attempted but failed to overpower Jesus Christ. satan uses the same wicked strategy on everyone: (1) the lusts of the eyes; (2) the lusts of the flesh; and (3) the pride of life. satan tries to isolate you with his lame suggestions to get you to act independently of God which triggers infidelity, ultimately idolatry.

His only goal is to persuade you to worship him to enslave you. You will never be free under satan's rule, although it may seem pleasurable for a season. In that state, you won't be free to serve the one and only, true and living God. The temporary pleasure is only a mirage because satan can only give you what he is full of: fear, confusion, hate, murder, envy, strife, and destruction.

Romans 6:16-18 unveils the difference between the two pledges of allegiance. “Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.”

Jesus did not yield to an easier way out to reestablish the kingdom of God. Jesus refused satan’s invitation to dethrone God. Jesus was already convinced he held the seat of honor--sitting on the right hand of God. Jesus knew God personally and intimately so He stuck to His master plan. Jesus committed to finishing His assignment as God purposed it. Jesus was commissioned as God’s best way of escape for mankind. Jesus accomplished His Heavenly Father’s business, i.e., sacrificially saving mankind to the uttermost rather than accepting temporary and immediate gratification for the flesh.

Jesus had foreknowledge of His own victory because He already knew Revelation 11:15 to be the truth before it was ever written. This Word was finished before the foundations of the world that “...The kingdoms of this world *are* become the kingdoms of our Lord and His Christ; and He shall reign forever and ever.” According to that prophecy, whatever is influenced by the devil is already generated into the kingdom of God and Jesus Christ’s for eternity.

The devil is already overpowered by the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. All the devil’s effects have been

in vain. That's why he acts so desperate because he is fighting a losing battle. Jesus conquered the cycle of death and destruction ruling even in areas the devil considers his own territory, the kingdoms of this world.

Jesus already delivered you from the fear of death by making you more than a conqueror through Him. Your assignment is to maintain the victory already won. Keep satan defeated by keeping him in subjection to you. Never negotiate with him. Keep the devil outlawed within your jurisdiction uninterruptedly so Jesus can be Lord. Don't be mistaken. It is going to be that way, whether or not you actively participate in the kingdom of God business.

Be certain that God desires you to fully participate as His heir, but your lack of participation will not even cause a delay. The worst that can happen is you will never wear the crown as a partaker of God's divine nature. When you choose to be an observer only, you are easy prey to be victimized by satan. satan's plot is to entrap you into any compromising behavior so you can't escape the lusts that are in the world through the flesh. The biggest kind of nonconformity is unbelief, which exempts you from reigning.

Jesus outlasted temptation because he was full of the Holy Spirit, the Word, and the power of God. Therefore, He destroyed the works of the devil. That same Jesus lives within you to empower you with His royal authority today. Romans 8:11 shows your seamless connection to Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. "But if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ

from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in you.”

Resurrection power also indwells you because of the authority of the anointing, so you can speak words of life and receive supernatural results. Isaiah 59:19 vividly illustrates the results. “...When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.” You are the standard God raised up so no flood can breakthrough because God is your fortified defense.

In I Samuel 30th chapter, David inquired of the Lord whether or not he should pursue his enemy regarding the burned and desolate city of Zigelag and his abducted people. The Lord advised him to go reverse the curse [things that cause you to fail]; go retrieve what belongs to you; go rescue the perishing; go restore the order, balance, and wholeness to your family, home, workplace, and city. David did exactly what God commanded and recovered all. He and his men defended and rescued the whole city. They stripped the enemy of his power and delivered all their people, property, and possessions. With that victory, the corrupt world system succumbed to David’s rule in just one day when he received and acted on God’s counsel. They recovered all because what they believed gave them the victory and they turned their enemy upside down and inside out.

Additionally, David and his army seized the enemy’s possessions, so in the end they received much more than they lost. They contained the enemy’s portion because they made enough room to receive the extras. Moreover, it was approved by God for them to take the spoils of war.

AFTERWORD

Command the Invisible

"For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be known and come abroad."

Luke 8:17

Success is achieved when you command the invisible and expect it to submit. When your situation is no longer impossible to you, just the answer unseen you are one step away from manifestation of the promise. The proof you possess is founded on the anointed Word of God you release in faith that the Holy Spirit is eagerly waiting for. You are not waiting on God. His work has been finished from the foundations of the world.

What you can't see created everything you can see because of this sound biblical principle: The Word became flesh and dwelt among us and we behold the glory of the Lord through Jesus Christ. With your royal authority, you call things that be not as though they were. Since the worlds were framed by the Word of God, be determined that your world will closely follow that same pattern.

You cannot be influenced by anything you cannot see spiritually. God wants to show you His divine secrets, so you are equipped to usher in the glory of the Lord to reclaim His territory. You are privileged to receive inside information.

To do so begin to ask for clarity and receive clarity by maintaining a listening ear on the inside. Since you have an enemy, acquire intelligence, as well as, position yourself so he cannot receive any information. The answer to expect is to: (1) gain knowledge that something exists, (2) to bind the enemy from interrupting or interfering with the will of God, or (3) surface a thing so it will be seen by the naked eye.

I have personally applied Luke 12:2 almost every day dating back to late 1988. "For there is nothing covered, that shall be revealed; neither hid that shall not be known." God has been faithful to keep me well informed on both critical and mundane issues in my life, workplace, ministry, businesses, and city.
