CLASS CATEGORIES, DESIGNATIONS & RULES

"Youth / Juvenile Riders" – age 18 and under as of January 1, 2022

Helmet Rule: ASTM approved Helmet required for youth in all jumping classes and in all speed events. Helmets strongly encouraged for youth in all classes & helmets not penalized in any class.

Handler Permitted / Coached Classes: Coach allowed in ring and to give verbal assistance. Coach allowed to assist rider if safety is in jeopardy or at judge's discretion. Riders may only cross-enter into Coached / Beginner classes, lead-line, and costume

Beginner Rider Classes: Open to students in their first or second year of showing in their performance division. May not enter canter classes.

Beginner Pole and Barrel: Must walk or trot through the weaving pattern. Cantering only allowed on straight stretches. Cantering through poles will result in a time penalty at judge's discretion.
