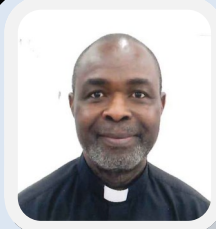

THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Why a Sacrament of Reconciliation After Baptism? §1425

1425 "You were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God." One must appreciate the magnitude of the gift God has given us in the sacraments of Christian initiation in order to grasp the degree to which sin is excluded for him who has "put on Christ." But the apostle John also says: "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." And the Lord himself taught us to pray: "Forgive us our trespasses," linking our forgiveness of one another's offenses to the forgiveness of our sins that God will grant us.

CATECISMO DE LA IGLESIA CATOLICA

Por qué un sacramento de la Reconciliación después del Bautismo §1425

1425 "Habéis sido lavados [...] habéis sido santificados, [...] habéis sido justificados en el nombre del Señor Jesucristo y por el Espíritu de nuestro Dios" (1 Co 6,11). Es preciso darse cuenta de la grandeza del don de Dios que se nos hace en los sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana para comprender hasta qué punto el pecado es algo que no cabe en aquel que "se ha revestido de Cristo" (Ga 3,27). Pero el apóstol san Juan dice también: "Si decimos que no tenemos pecado, nos engañamos y la verdad no está en nosotros" (1 Jn 1,8). Y el Señor mismo nos enseñó a orar: "Perdona nuestras ofensas" (Lc 11,4) uniendo el perdón mutuo de nuestras ofensas al perdón que Dios concederá a nuestros pecados.

SAINT JOHN BAPTIST DE LA SALLE Feast Day April 7

Saint John Baptist de la Salle is another example of a man who looked forward to a life of dignified ease in a high position in the Church but for whom God had other plans. While always dedicated to what he saw as God's will he became aware of the grave need in society at that time for the creation of schools for poor boys. While initially distasteful he became involved in working with the deprived youths and the poor to whom he ultimately devoted his entire life. He founded, the Christian Brothers which were successful in educating boys of poor families. It prepared teachers in the first training college for teachers and also set up homes and schools for young delinquents. While trials and successes abounded in the end his new and fruitful methods brought Christian education and improved opportunities to many poor boys who would otherwise have had no other options. He was canonized in 1900.

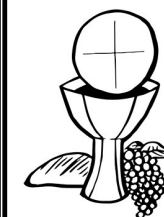
NEXT YOUTH MASS SUNDAY, MAY 12, 8:15 AM
