This includes acknowledging that Jackman Community Daycare employees do not provide paid or unpaid babysitting services to families who are registered with the centre. This policy conforms to current professional standards that aim to avoid a potential or perceived conflict of interest.

Please leave a detailed message in your child's daycare room whenever your child will not be attending daycare. If your child is sick, please tell us the symptoms so that we can track a possible outbreak. Updating Pick Up Lists & Special Consents

Your child's emergency contact form lists who can pick up your child, either anytime or with a note of phone call. Under no circumstances will the daycare release your child to someone with just a phone call if **prior written consent** has not been given. If you are unsure as to who is currently on your child's pick up list or have an update, please come to the daycare office, room 308, to update your information. **We strongly encourage you to** *proactively* add people to your pickup list. That way you can just phone your child's rooms to let staff know who is picking up.

If you have a one-time special pick up, or if your child will be participating in school activities, you can fill out a blue special consent form located in all daycare rooms and on our website, or leave a note with staff in the morning or the night before. **We can no longer accept emails for this purpose so please do not email the daycare office staff about special pickups. Thank you.**
