

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2018-37**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78 PARKING SCHEDULES  
TO ADOPT PARKING RESTRICTIONS WITHIN THE  
WOODSIDE PARK SUBDIVISION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Amelia Village Council (“Village Council”) has codified certain parking regulations on streets within the Village for the safety of residents and others traveling on such streets.

**WHEREAS**, The Village’s Fire Department has advised Village Council that in order to comply with the Fire Code and ensure the safety of fire and emergency operations in the designated areas, the Amelia Code of Ordinances should be amended to limit parking on certain streets within the Woodside Park Subdivision.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

**SECTION 1:** The Amelia Code of Ordinances Chapter 78 Schedule 1 shall be amended, in part, to include the following additional parking restrictions on Woodside Park Drive, Cedarwood Drive, Ashwood Place, Belwood Court, Woodsong Court and Parkwood Place within the Woodside Park Subdivision:

**CHAPTER 78 PARKING SCHEDULES**

**SECTION 2:** That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and well-being of the residents of the Village in order to immediately begin implementation of the parking regulations of vehicles on the designated streets.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MR. FITE seconded the motion.




