SECRETARY REPORT

The general membership meeting was held on July 16, 2016 at the home of Edna Wood in Martelle, Iowa. There were 15 members present.

The meeting was called to order by President, Dave Robinson.

Gary Price read the Treasurer's report.

The secretary report was read by Stephanie Kinney (acting secretary for Denise Wiles).

OLD BUSINESS

Gary Price reported on the AMHR show expenses and income.

There was discussion about what amount to pay the 4-H club that handed out ribbons at our AMHR show. Gary Price made a motion to pay the 4-H club \$250 per day. Karen Wales seconded the motion, motion carried.

Dave Robinson thanked all of the members that worked at the 2016 AMHR show.

NEW BUSINESS

Clark Wood reported that AAMHC is booked for June 17 & 18, 2017 for our next AMHR show at Kirkwood.

There was discussion about the AAMHC sponsoring a table at the 2016 AMHR Nationals. Stephanie Kinney made a motion to sponsor a table at the Nationals for the \$300 fee. Motioned seconded by Tammy Lowe. Motion carried.

The Iowa State Fair 4-H put in a request for AAMHC to sponsor Miniature Horse classes for 2016. Sponsorship is \$175 per class. Clark Wood made a motion to sponsor the 4-H Iowa State Fair classes. Terry Kinney seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mindy Meyer reported on the progress of the 2016 AAMHC Fun Show. It will be held at the Benton County Fairgrounds, Vinton, Iowa on October 1, 2016. The show begins at 10:00 AM. Hillary Lynch will be the judge.

Karen Wales reported on the Mississippi Valley Fair AMHR show to be held August 4, 2016 in Davenport, Iowa. She was requesting volunteers to help with the show.

Dave Robinson received a letter from AMHA, requesting a donation/sponsorship for AMHA youth. After discussion the club members declined the offer, since our club does not have youth that attend the AMHA National Show.

Gary Price submitted a bill in the amount of \$51.36 to be reimbursed for copies made for the AAMHC June 2016 show. Larry Lowe made a motion to reimburse Gary, Dave Robinson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The subject of having another clinic hosted by AAMHC was brought up. Clark Wood talked to Jon Wolf about possibly being our clinician. This would be a one day clinic, Jon's fee is \$300 per day, plus mileage. Clark will check with Jon about a possible end of October 2016 date.

It was suggested to hire/pay our ringman, a gate person and center ring secretary for the June 2017 AMHR show. Joel Stohlmann (ringman) and Deb Robinson (center ring secretary) have held these positions for all of the past shows without pay. Joel and Deb will have first priority to be offered these paid positions. If they decline to hold these positions, outside sources would be hired for these positions. There was a long discussion about this. Many members agreed those members that are working the show for 2 days do not have sufficient time to work at their post and show their horses comfortably without rushing to get back to their posts after showing their horses. Many members need a break and would like to enjoy the show and have sufficient time to prepare their horses for the show ring. Those working the show these past years also stated if they did not have to work during the show, they would be willing to bring more horses to show, thus increasing entries.

Gary Price suggested that we get Randy Martin (show steward) and Jerry Knowling (announcer) booked for the 2017 AMHR show as soon as possible. Clark Wood will speak to Dixci about being our show manager again for 2017.

The next membership meeting will be held at the Fun Show in Vinton, Iowa in October. Details to follow at a later date.

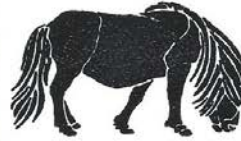
