

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

March 21, 2016

The Jewell County Commissioners met March 21, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. with Commissioners, Steve Greene and Dwight S. Frost present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was also present.

The minutes of the March 14, 2016 County Commissioners meeting were approved as printed.

Myron and Lawrence Bouray discussed the right of way where the road is being worked by their property. They shared concerns that the Road & Bridge Department entered on their property while repairing the road. Myron and Lawrence have pictures of the area of concern. The Commissioners said they will look into the situation.

Chris Petet, Custodian, had quotes to get the courthouse roof coated: Tillotson Enterprises Spray Applications - \$37,385.00 for 48 mils + 13.5 dry; Tillotson Enterprises Spray Applications - \$32,200.00 for 50 mils + 17 dry; and Geisler Roof - \$28,980.00. Dwight S. Frost moved and Steve Greene seconded to approve Geisler Roofing quote of \$28,980.00 for the prep, flashing/detail and coating. Motion passed.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, said the ADAPT Program gave \$100 to the Safe Program and \$200 to the National Child Safety Fund. The Sheriff's Office is working to get the 800 radios operational. He discussed the impounded pickup. Don also discussed getting the electronic fingerprint machine. Don had quotes for a digital radio for the pickup: Mr. Testor - \$550; Surplus Radios -\$895; Pierce Electronics - \$625 includes programming. Dwight S. Frost moved and Steve Greene seconded the motion to purchase the digital radio for \$625 from Pierce Electronics. Motion passed.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, reported on road & bridge maintenance. Joel said he had requests for speed limit signs on the east and west the edge of Burr Oak. Carla Waugh reported that the Community Development sign along Highway 14 at the intersection of Lake Shore Road needs repaired. She was advised by Lisa Goodheart that it was the County's responsibility to repair the sign. The Commissioners discussed Myron and Lawrence Bouray's concerns on the work completed on their road last week. The Commissioners reported other road concerns.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff and Gail Bartley, Emergency Preparedness Director and 911 Coordinator, discussed the installation of the 9-1-1 system and electrical line. The system will need to be in a temperature controlled room. Chris Petet, Custodian, was also present for the discussion.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, discussed burn permits. Carla Waugh provided copies of Resolution 94-03 concerning the county burn ban and permits.

Carla Waugh had the application for "License to Sell Cereal Malt Beverages" from Aaron and Jana Coil D.B.A. Lovewell Marina. Carla sent notice to Sinclair Township and received it back with approval. Steve Greene moved that the proper officers sign the Cereal Malt Beverage License for Aaron and Jana Coil D.B.A. Lovewell Marina. Dwight S. Frost seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
