Epistle: Romans 2:10-16;

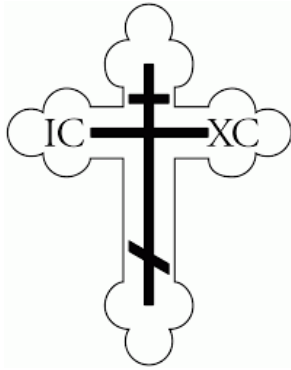
Last week we celebrated the first Sunday after Pentecost. (All Saints). "All Christian holiness is a fruit of Pentecost there is therefore a logical link between this feast and that of the Sunday of Pentecost. The second Sunday after Pentecost (today) shows us the practical applications of the great call to renunciation formulated by Jesus in the Gospel for the first Sunday. The gospel read today at the liturgy tells of the calling of the first apostles. The epistle deals with themes of the law and of the faith that we will continue to consider on the following Sundays."¹

Epistle: Romans 2:10-16

¹⁰ But there will be glory, honor, and peace for everyone who practices doing good, initially for Jews but also for Greeks as well, ¹¹ because God does not show partiality.

¹² For all who have sinned apart from the Law will also perish apart from the Law, and all who have sinned under the Law will be judged by the Law. ¹³ For it is not merely those who hear the Law who are righteous in God's sight. No, it is those who follow the Law, who will be justified. ¹⁴ For whenever gentiles, who do not possess the Law, do instinctively what the Law requires, they are a law to themselves, even though they do not have the

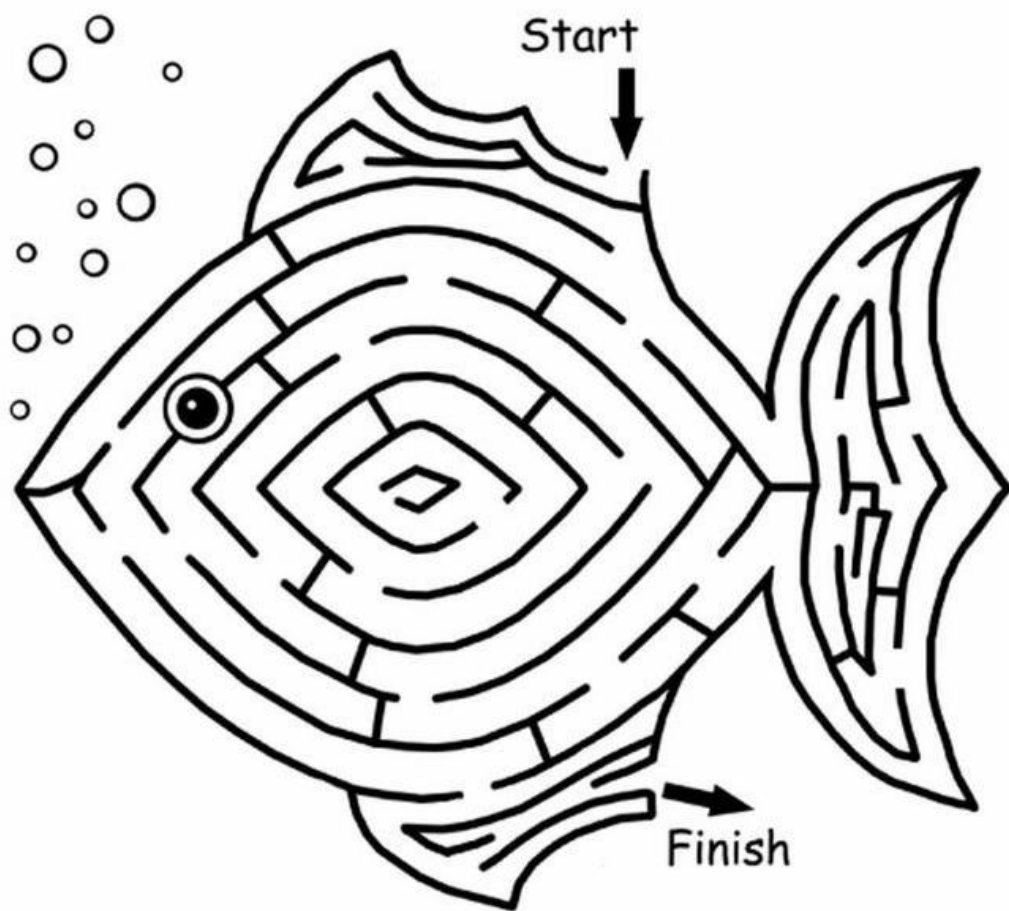
