

Dear friends,

Last month, I wrote about starting a game of stumping the pastor. I have put some pages on the large table in the entryway. Go ahead and take one and start thinking about all those complicated questions that have been burning in your heart. Along with these pages, you can also just pass me notes or e-mails.

A couple of weeks ago, I was asked about my opinion on the movie "Noah" from 2014, starring Russell Crowe, Jennifer Connelly, and Anthony Hopkins. There are certainly some things that I liked about that movie, probably the biggest one was the depiction of the ark as a giant box instead of a boat. An ark, by definition, is a box with a lid, not a boat. I've always wondered why we imagine Noah's ark as a boat. Wouldn't it get flooded and sink by all the rainwater if it had an open top?

But there are other aspects of that movie that weren't so great. According to the Bible, one of the instigating factors for the flood was the appearance of "Nephilim" or the children of angels and humans. That's kind of a weird idea, but the Bible sums it up by telling us that "These were the heroes that were of old, warriors of renown" (Genesis 6:4). In other words, this is how our ancestors understood all the myths of other cultures and religions that surrounded them, that these famous ancient heroes were "Nephilim." Unfortunately, God did not like this attempt at human beings trying to save themselves, and so God wanted to rid the world of these creatures. However, in that 2014 movie, the Nephilim were depicted as weird rock monsters, which is very different from the story that we have received.

This movie also troubled me with the depiction of Noah being quite fatalistic about the whole proposition. It seems he never did trust that the ark would save him, his family, and the animals, and Noah was portrayed in that film as wanted to eliminate all of humanity. But the Noah of scripture trusted in God to save and salvage humankind from the violence of the earth brought about by the Nephilim. So all in all, it was a weird but interesting depiction of this Biblical story, and no matter how close or far the film deviated from the Bible, both versions of the story encourages us to think about the meaning and significance of life, and how all life, whether ours, our neighbors, or the plants and animals that surround us, must be protected and cherished because God is a creator God, and a God of life.

Here in May, we will conclude the Easter season by remembering the promise of Jesus' ascension so that he can be with us everywhere and at all times, and then move to Pentecost, the celebration of the Holy Spirit in our lives. We will conclude our worship in May with the Holy Trinity Sunday, that annual celebration of the God who is a living, loving relationship who invites us to join into that relationship.

I'll start taking a little bit of vacation time here in May and through the summer. We're not planning any big trips this year, just some time off to see family and friends and have a couple small adventures that I will tell you all about later.
