ON-LINE AND MAIL-IN FEES

\$25 Registration Fee + \$10 Sport Fee per event if registering on or before December 15.
\$30 Registration Fee + \$10 Sport Fee per event if registering December 16 thru February 8.
Paper registration is available but will incur a \$5. Data Entry Fee and must be postmarked by Dec. 15.
Registration fee is charged one time only per person.

ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. Athletes must qualify in each tennis event in which they wish to compete at the 2019 National Senior Games.
2. Players may compete with only one (1) partner per event.
3. Players may compete in only one (1) age division per event.
4. Players must provide their own racquets and bring a can of new balls for each match played.
5. Age group for Doubles determined by the age of the younger player.
6. Players must include their ranking, whether USTA or other. If you are unsure of your ranking, please call the Tennis Commissioner.
7. Competition is in 5 year age groups: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69 etc. The Commissioner may combine age groups if necessary for competition however, medals will be awarded by age group. Doubles/Mx Doubles will play in the age group of the younger player. Ages are determined as of 12/31/18.
8. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to winners in each age group.

FORMAT

1. Single elimination tournament will be played.
2. Commissioner reserves the right to modify any draw.

SPORT RULES

1. USTA/NSGA rules will apply except as noted herein. NSGA rules will supersede if necessary.
2. Players in multiple events may play more than one match per day. Attempts will be made to schedule in such a way as to avoid conflicts between events. However, it is the responsibility of the player to make conflicts known to the Commissioner in sufficient time to re-schedule if possible, or withdraw.
3. Players may have to play more than one match per day based on number of players per event.
