Invasive species: presentation of invasive species: Phragmites (common reed), Lythrum (purple loosestrife)
Best to Round Up these weeds. Purple loosestrife best cut and thrown
Away (not recycled) and use Round Up on the stump
Found Eurasian milfoil and curley-leaf pondweed at two launches
Handout on proper cleaning of boats that are transported from lake to lake

Recommendation to use Aqua Weed Control
