

US Naval Academy Camping Trip

November 10 - 12, 2023

WHAT: Camping trip to Kinder Farm Park, Millersville, Maryland (https://www.aacounty.org/recreation-parks/parks/kinder-farm-park); tour of the US Naval Academy; ticket to the Navy/University of Alabama- Birmingham football game at Navy-Marine Corps Stadium (https://navysports.com/sports/2022/5/25/navy-marine-corps-memorial-stadium.aspx)

WHEN: Friday, November 10, 2023 to Sunday, November 12, 2023

WHO (in this order): Registered Troop 78 Scouts and visiting Webelos; Adults registered with the BSA Bus drivers; uniformed Scoutmaster and ASMs; visiting Webelos adults accompanying a visiting Webelos; veterans; other male adults

COST: NO CHARGE for Scouts and visiting Webelos; \$75 for adults

TICKETS ARE LIMITED, as is campsite space. Scout reservations come first. Adults will be waitlisted for attendance.

SCHEDULE:

- Meet Friday night November 10th at the Cabin by NO LATER THAN 6:30 PM
- Arrive back at the Cabin at approximately **11:00 AM** on **Sunday, November 10th. Scouts will call when we are 20 minutes from the Cabin on our return.**

Notify your Patrol Leader by turning in your completed Permission and Release Form (attached) by no later than Monday, November 6th **at 7:00 PM** if you will be attending. Indicate on the form if your father/male guardian is attending as well.

AT LEAST one QT/L water bottle, filled

Drinking cup

Toothbrush and toothpaste; soap (camping soap preferred); small towel

Small bottle hand sanitizer

Pocketknife

Sneakers (to wear in camp)

Wool or synthetic socks – wear a pair, bring TWO PAIRS

Change of clothes

Brimmed hat

Small container of sunscreen; Chapstick

Warm hat and gloves

Rain gear

Warm jacket (not just a sweatshirt)
