Update on Pinyon development	Robert updated the group on the following issues regarding the large development at Avenue 34 and Pasadena Avenue. -The driveway has been approved for Pasadena as compared to Avenue 34; -Remediation work is being planned now; Discussion followed	No action taken
New truck	The situation with the truck was discussed. Joe reported that the truck can still be used for a few more months. We have the funds to purchase a used truck, but we can wait until the current truck is no longer functional	No action taken
Artesian Market update	Peter gave an update on the status of the market since the shut down by the City. Neighbors on Humboldt are now seeing the growth of new vendors. There is currently a security guard set at a gate at Artesian that keeps people out of the truck traffic at the Gertmenian site. It is costing the company \$1500 per week to have a guard present. They are looking at vacating the street to only the truck traffic. The guard works from 9:30 to 5:00 p.m. every day. Peter asked if the BID Board can help fund this guard since it benefits everyone. The Board thought that it could afford \$3,000 per month (half the costs) for 3 months. This would cost \$9,000 to the Board.	Seth moved and Joe seconded allocating an amount not to exceed \$9,000 for the three month period from December thru February to help offset the cost of the daily guard. The motion was approved unanimously.
