Dear Band Directors and Boosters,

Welcome to the 37th Annual Vista Invitational Field Tournament! Included in this packet are the procedures and schedules for today. We hope you enjoy your time with us, and have a wonderful performance!

Arrival:

The tournament hosts will stamp the hands of all students and chaperones while the buses proceed to the assigned spaces in the participant parking area. There are **NO** wristbands.

Director's Check-In:

Upon arrival Directors, please check in at the check-in table in front of the band room (see campus map). You will be directed to your warm up area.

Spectator Arrival and Parking:

Spectator parking is available on Bobier Drive and throughout nearby residential neighborhoods. Make sure to observe all city and shopping center parking regulations, as the San Diego County Sherriff will patrol the streets. Limited handicapped parking is available on campus (see map included). Premium parking is also available on site at Vista High School and across the street at the Vista Adult Transition Center for \$10.00 per vehicle.

Tickets:

Every spectator attending the tournament is required to purchase admission. Spectator tickets are available at the ticket office for a cost of **\$12.00 per adult, \$10.00 for seniors/students/children**. Children 2 years old and younger are admitted for free. You will receive a **\$2.00 discount** when you purchase your program at the same time you purchase your admission (regular program price: \$5.00).

Security:

THERE ARE NO STORAGE OR DRESSING FACILITIES PROVIDED. EACH BAND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS EQUIPMENT. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME. Vista High School will be providing security guards, who will make regular checks of our campus parking lot; however, we must issue this disclaimer for all buses and accompanying vehicles:

THE VISTA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, VISTA HIGH SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION OR VISTA HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS CANNOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE TO REPLACE LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.

Food Service:

Food service will be available for spectators and participants at two concessions locations: spectator (home) side of the stadium and the visitor side of the stadium.

- **NOTE FOR PARENTS AND FRIENDS ATTENDING:** Our school district policy prohibits patrons from bringing any containers or coolers into the stadium. Please notify your group of this policy.

Kid Feeds:

NO FLAMES OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED (due to fire regulations). NO EXCEPTIONS.

Hospitality:

You are cordially invited to visit the hospitality tent located on the North end of the field. We invite you to come and enjoy our fantastic food, hot and cold beverages, and friendly faces. Tournament name badges are required.

- Special Note: The judges will have a sectioned off area to dine in during the 45 minute dinner break. Since their judging responsibilities will not yet be concluded, please show the appropriate professional courtesy while sharing this area. Thank you.

Chaperones:

Students and designated chaperones have free admission to their band's designated areas of the stadium. Students and chaperones will be stamped on the buses upon entry to the school.

Souvenirs:

Tournament souvenirs (shirts, buttons, and programs) will be available on both sides of the stadium.

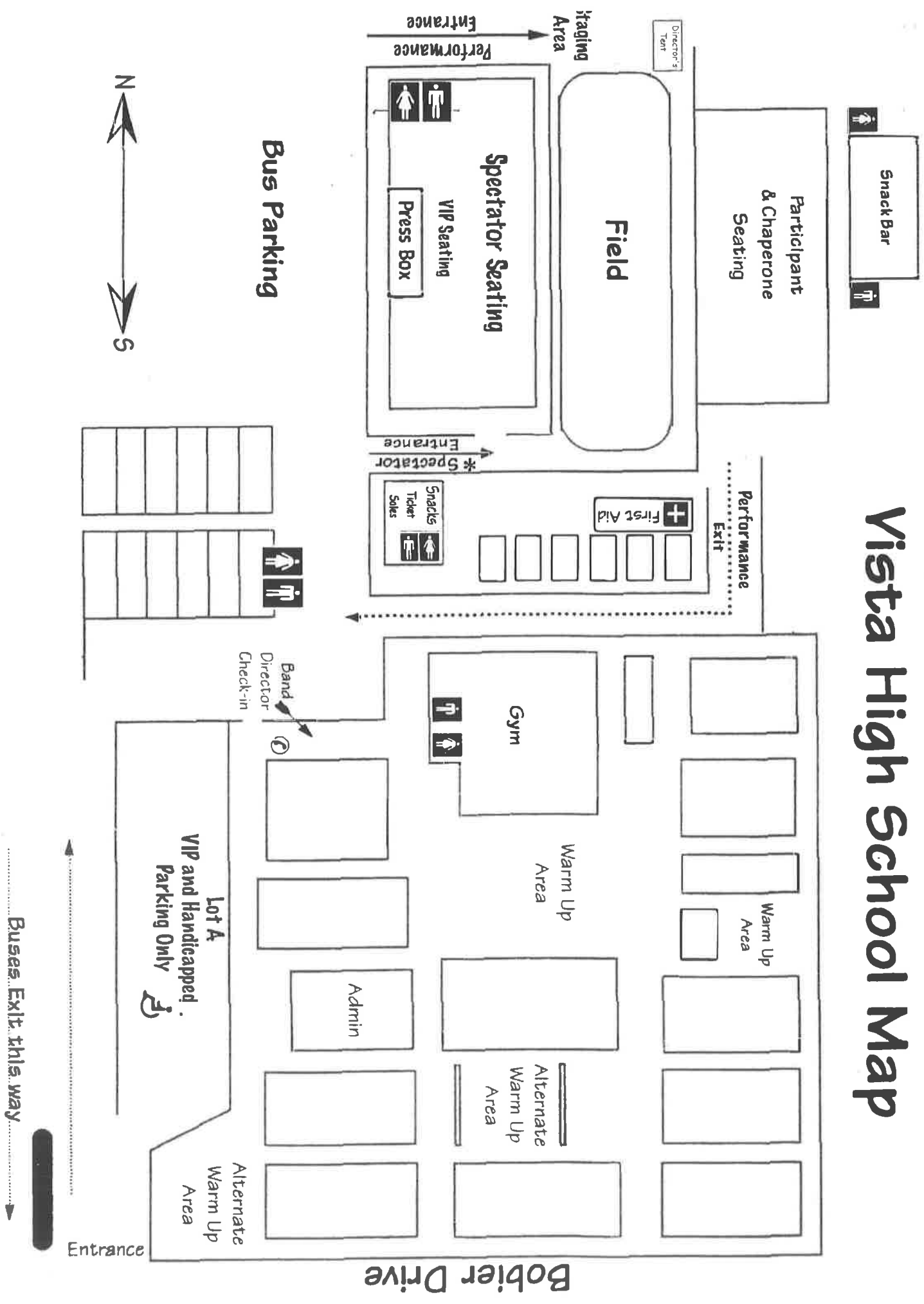
Photographer:

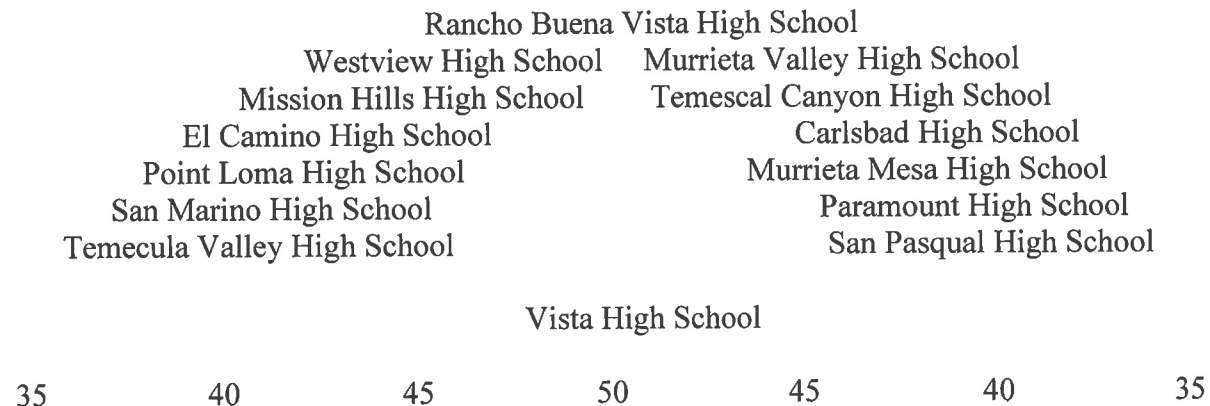


Vista Invitational Field Tournament Closing Ceremonies

After the final band (Rancho Buena Vista High School) completes their performance, Drum Majors and student leaders should report to the "Performance Exit" ramp, located at the South end of the Visitor's Side.

Once all band honor guards are present and lined up in presentation order, the honor guard will walk down the track to the Visitor's Side 50 yard line, then turn and walk onto the field, stopping just before the Panther emblem to wait for the announcer.

When announced, that band's honor guard will do a very short salute, and the Vista student leaders will return the salute. A representative from the Vista High School Band Boosters will direct the leadership from that school to their places using the diagram below:



After all schools are in place, we will await the call from the judges to begin the presentation of the trophies. Trophies will start with 1st Place Auxiliary (all divisions), followed by 1st Place Percussion (all divisions), and finally 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place Band (all divisions). We will complete our tournament with Sweepstakes Awards for overall Auxiliary, overall Percussion, overall Visual Effect, the Monica Duren High Visual Award, the John Vorwald High Music Award, and the Ken Gammie Tournament Sweepstakes winner.
